

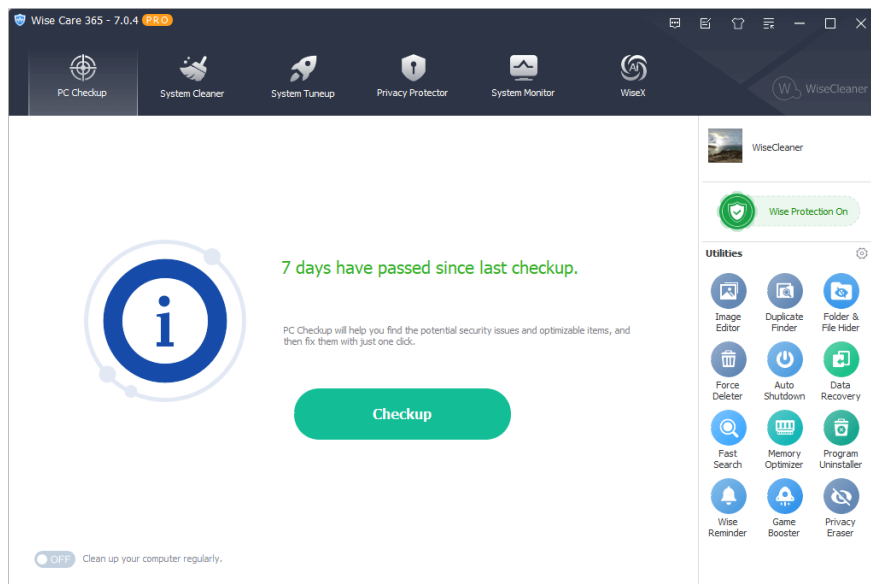

System Requirements

Wise Care 365 will run on any PC running Microsoft Windows XP and later. If you're running one of the following operating systems, it's OK to run Wise Care 365:

1. Windows 11 (All Windows editions, including both 32-bit and 64-bit)
2. Windows 10 (All Windows editions, including both 32-bit and 64-bit)
3. Windows 8/8.1 (All Windows editions, including both 32-bit and 64-bit)
4. Windows 7 (All Windows editions, including both 32-bit and 64-bit)
5. Windows Vista (All Windows editions, including both 32-bit and 64-bit)
6. Windows XP¹ (All Windows editions, including both 32-bit and 64-bit)

Since Wise Care 365 is a small and quick program, it takes less memory and needs fewer hard drive requirements.

Wise Care 365 does not support Mac OS or Linux.

¹: Only the portable version of Wise Care 365 v7 supports Windows XP.

1. Download

You are always welcome to download Wise Care 365 from our official site:

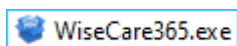

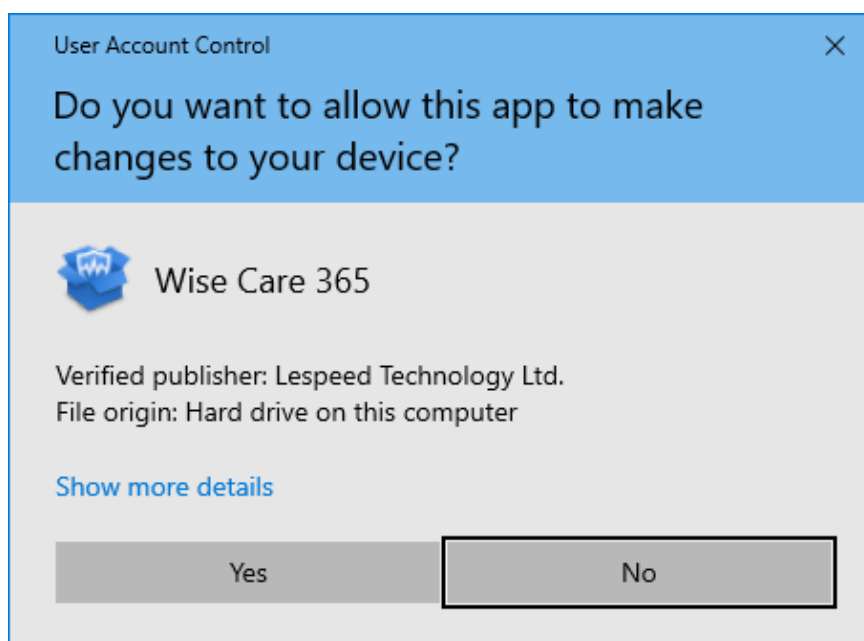

2. Install

After Wise Care 365 download finishes, please find out the setup file, double click



, and then click [**Yes**] after the following dialog box appears.



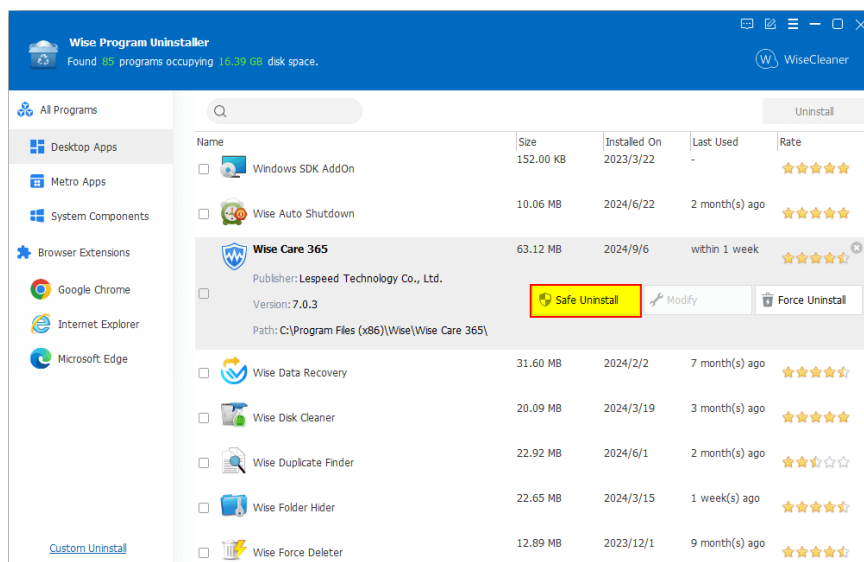
Then the installer will start automatically and will guide you through the rest of the installation process.

3. Remove / Uninstall

There are 3 methods to uninstall a program. Please ensure that the application has been closed.

Method 1: Use Wise Program Uninstaller

If you have installed [Wise Program Uninstaller](#), just open it, scroll and find the program you want to uninstall, select it, and then click [**Safe Uninstall**]. This is the simplest way to uninstall a program and no leftovers.



Method 2: Run the application self-uninstall program

Please open Wise Care 365 folder, find and run 

- If you are running a **32-bit** system, the folder is in: **C:\Program Files\Wise\Wise Care 365**
- If you are running a **64-bit** system, the folder is in: **C:\Program Files (x86)\Wise\Wise Care 365**

Method 3: Use the system Control Panel

- If you are running a Vista/Win7 system, please click **Start → Control Panel → Programs → Uninstall a Program**, scroll down and find the program you want to uninstall, then click **Uninstall**
- If you are running a Win 8 system, please click **Settings → Control Panel → Programs → Uninstall a Program**, scroll down and find the program you want to uninstall, then click **Uninstall**
- If you are running a Win 10 and Win 11 system, please right-click **Start → Settings → Apps → Apps & Features**, scroll down and find the program you want to uninstall, then click **Uninstall**

4. Upgrade

Please run the application, click **Menu - Check for Updates**.

Also, you can download the latest version from

<https://www.wisecleaner.com/download.html>. Please ensure Wise Care 365 has been closed, and then install the latest version.

The minor upgrade can directly install the new version \ (for example: 1.0-1.x\). The major upgrade needs to uninstall the old version, and then install the new version \ (for example: 1.x-2.x\)

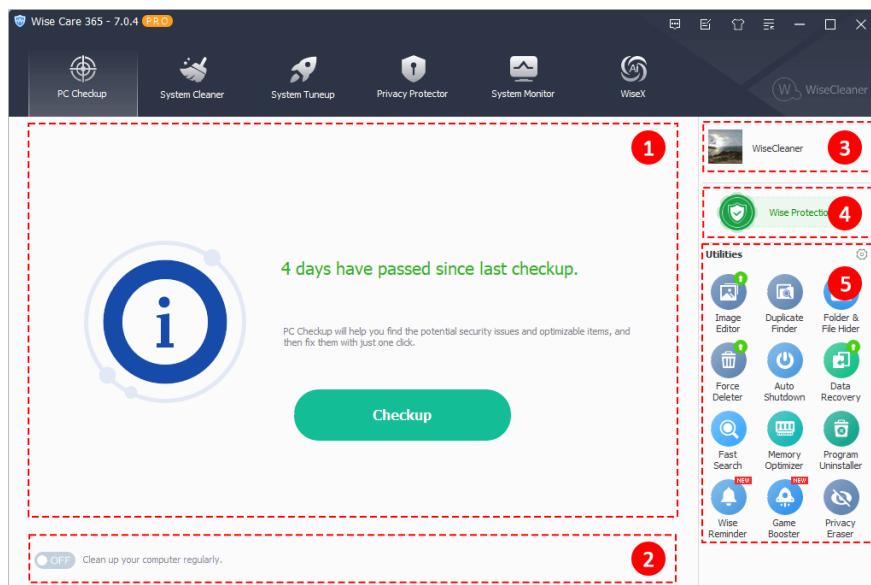

PC Checkup

The following picture is the main interface of Wise Care 365's PC Checkup. This interface is divided into 5 operation areas: [Checkup](#), [Schedule Task](#), [Avatar and Username](#), [Wise Protection](#), and [Utilities](#).



1. Checkup the System with 1-click

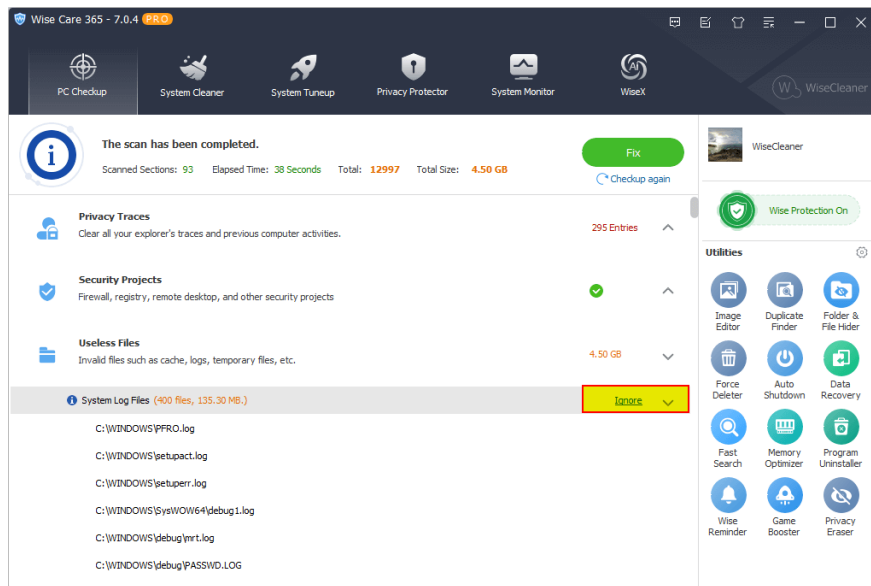
Click the largest green button in the middle of the window to quickly scan the system. Find useless files that can be cleaned and registry problems that can be fixed.

After scanning, the number and size of files that can be deleted will be displayed after the name of each item. For example, **System Log Files**, there are 6 files 2.02 MB in total that can be removed.

Click on an item to view details of which files can be removed. For example, **System Log Files**, click on it and you will see which files will be removed.

When you move the mouse pointer to an item, you will see the **Ignore** button. Click it to exclude this item, then Wise Care 365 will not clean files in this item, and will not scan this item in the future.

You also can customize the items of Checkup in [Menu -> Settings -> Custom Checkup](#).



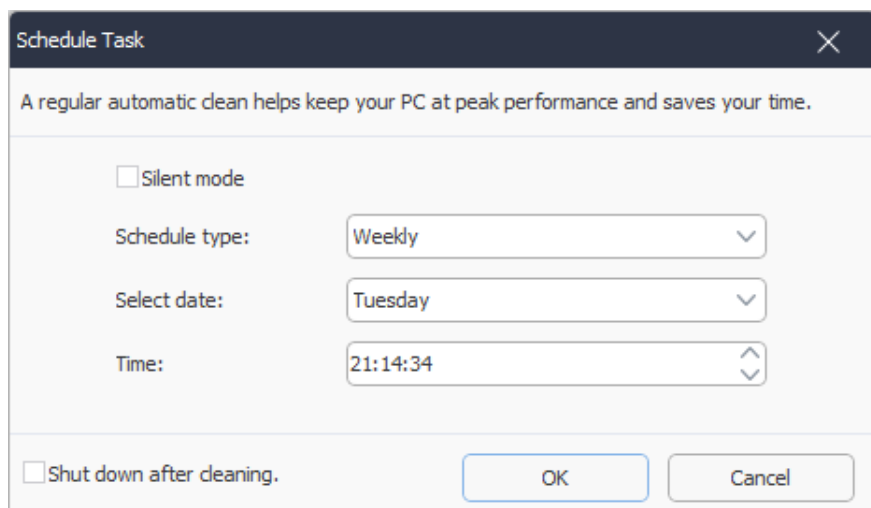
2. Schedule Task

This is used to customize a scheduled cleaning task, located in the bottom left corner of the window.

Task OFF: ☐ OFF Clean up your computer regularly.

Task ON: ☒ ON The next time: 2024/9/16 13:40

When the task is not started, you can click the button to open the task customization window, then set the run type, run day and run time, or choose shut down automatically after cleaning.

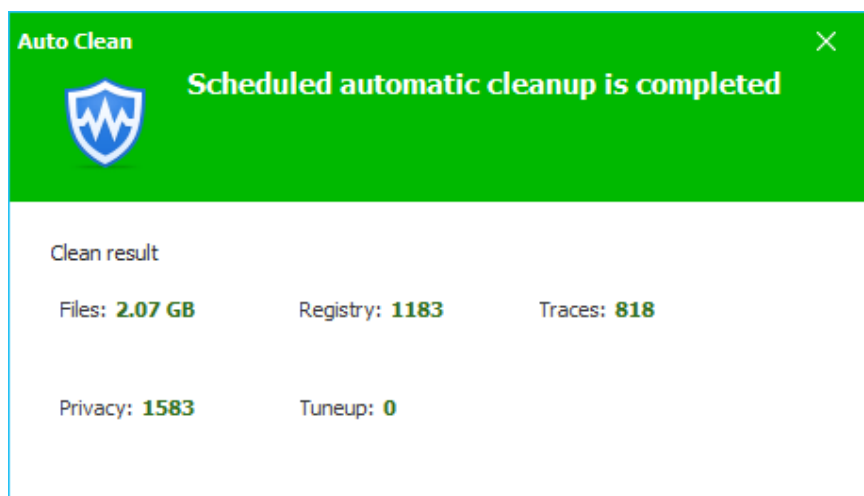


There are 5 task types: **Daily, Weekly, Monthly, On Idle, At login.**

- **Silent Mode**

When the silent mode is turned on, Wise Care 365 will not pop up the program interface when performing regular cleaning tasks and will run

scanning and cleaning as a background process. After the cleaning is completed, a notification window will appear in the lower right corner of the desktop, prompting the cleaning result.

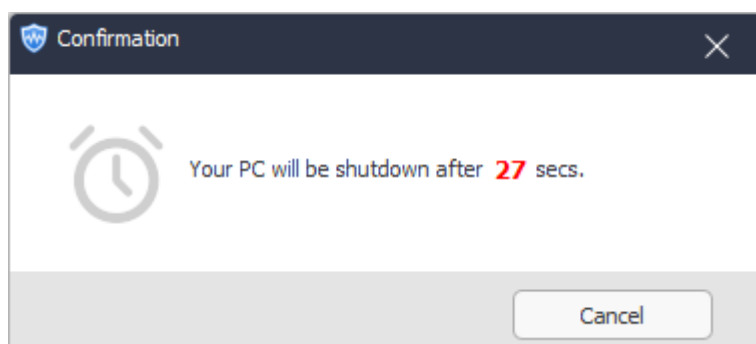


- **Non-Silent Mode**

Corresponding to the silent mode, when performing regular cleaning tasks, the main interface of Wise Care 365 will open, and then start scanning and cleaning the system.

- **Shut down after cleaning**

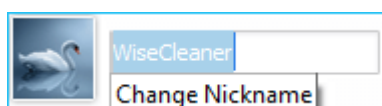
If this option is selected, your computer will shut down after 30 seconds.



3. Avatar and Username

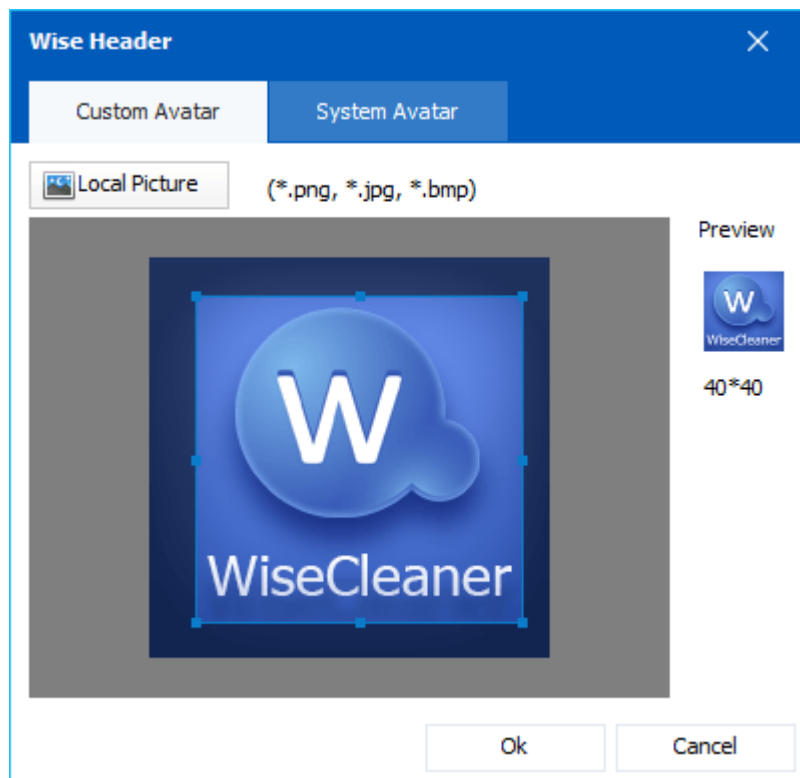
- **User Name**

Click the user name area, you can change the displayed name at any time.



- **Avatar**

Click on the avatar to open the avatar setting window. You can choose to add a local picture as an avatar, or you can use the avatar built into Wise Care 365.



4. Wise Protection

The old name is Real-time System Protection, located on the right side of the Wise Care 365 window, under the Avatar and Username.

Wise Protection, mainly to protect the key position of the registry, prevent applications from maliciously modifying the homepage settings of the IE browser, prevent applications from maliciously adding to system startup items, prevent applications from maliciously modifying the default browser, and block pop-up advertising windows of application.

You can view the details in the [Menu -> Settings -> System Protect](#).



5. Utilities

The Utility area is divided into 2 categories: Built-in Wise Care 365 and external to Wise Care 365. You can click the wrench icon in the upper right corner to expand all tools, and sort all utilities by dragging and dropping the icons.

- **External utilities**

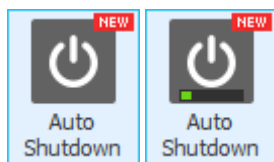
You need to download and install the installation package before you can use it. But these utilities are all products of WiseCleaner, so you can download them at the download center of WiseCleaner's website, you can also download them by clicking the corresponding icon in the utility area. Mainly include Duplicate Finder, Force Deleter, Auto Shutdown, Data Recovery, Fast Search, Memory Optimizer, Program Uninstaller, Wise Reminder, Game Booster.

- **Built-in utilities**

Don't need to install, just click the icon, then you can use it. Mainly include Privacy Eraser, Big Files Manager, Context Menu, Process Monitor, Startup Manager, Disk Defrag, etc.

- **Download utility**

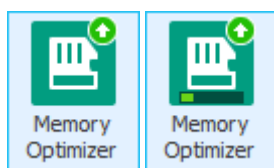
If there is a red **NEW** mark in the upper right corner of the icon, it means that the utility has not been installed yet. Click the icon to start downloading and installing automatically.



- **Update utility**

If there is a green **upward arrow** in the upper right corner of the icon, it means that the utility has a new update version. Click the green up arrow to start

updating immediately.

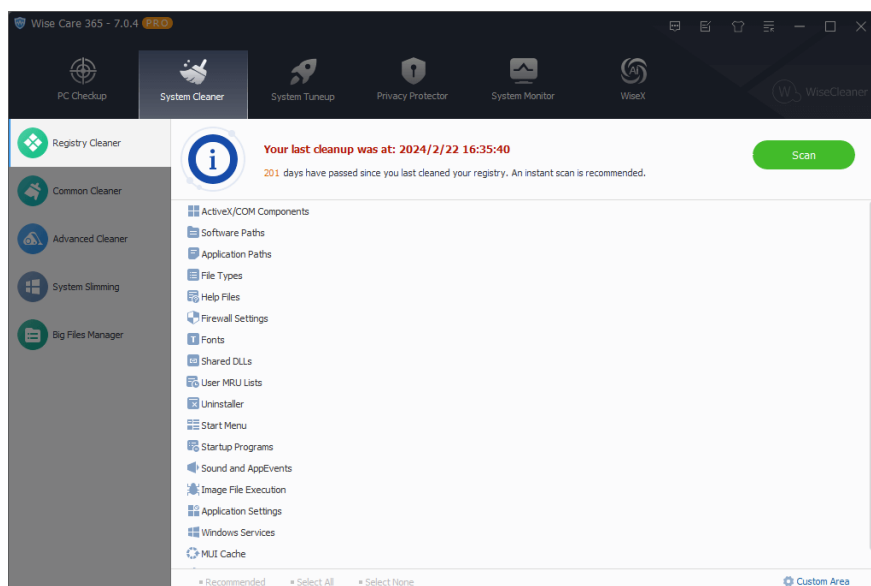
Registry Cleaner

Registry Cleaner can help you scan and clean invalid registry entries in the computer system, such as invalid Activex and COM components, invalid file extension information, missing shared dynamic-link library, useless or invalid uninstallation information, etc.

Wise Care 365 can automatically back up registry entries that are about to be deleted. You can view the registry records that have been backed up in [Menu -> Restore -> Registry Restore](#).

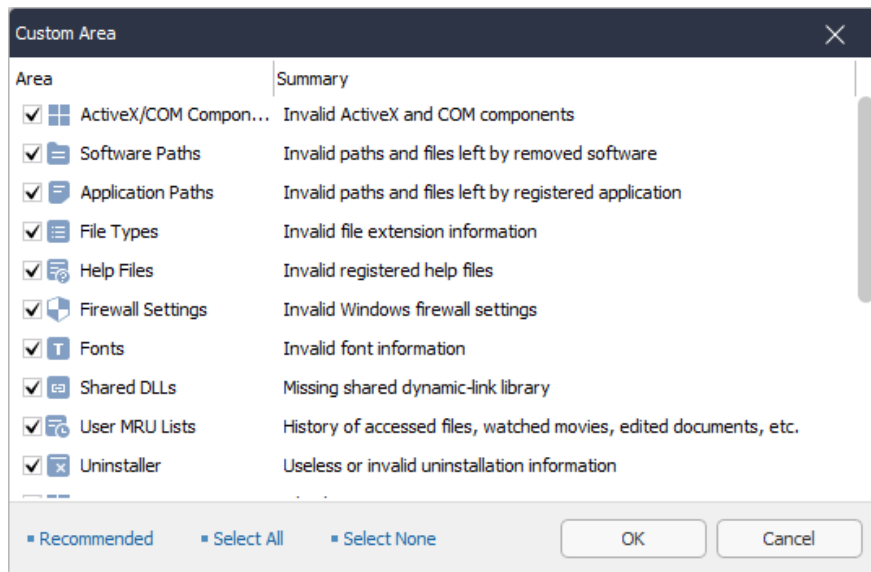
If you want to turn off the automatic backup function, you can disable it in [Menu -> Settings -> Cleaner](#).

It is not recommend turning off automatic backup.



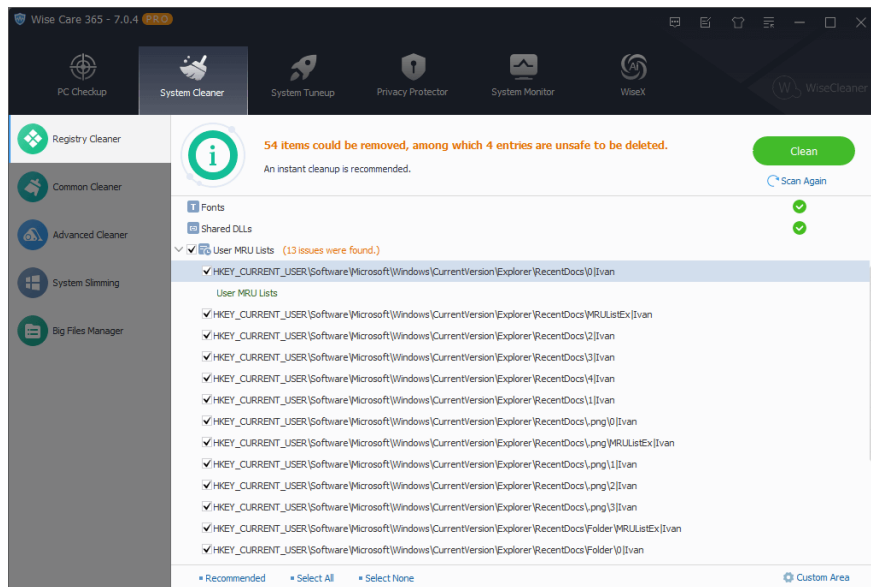
1. Customize the scanning and cleaning items of registry

We recommend using the **Recommended** settings, but you still can reset the items that need to be scanned and cleaned by clicking the **Custom Area** button in the lower right corner of the window.

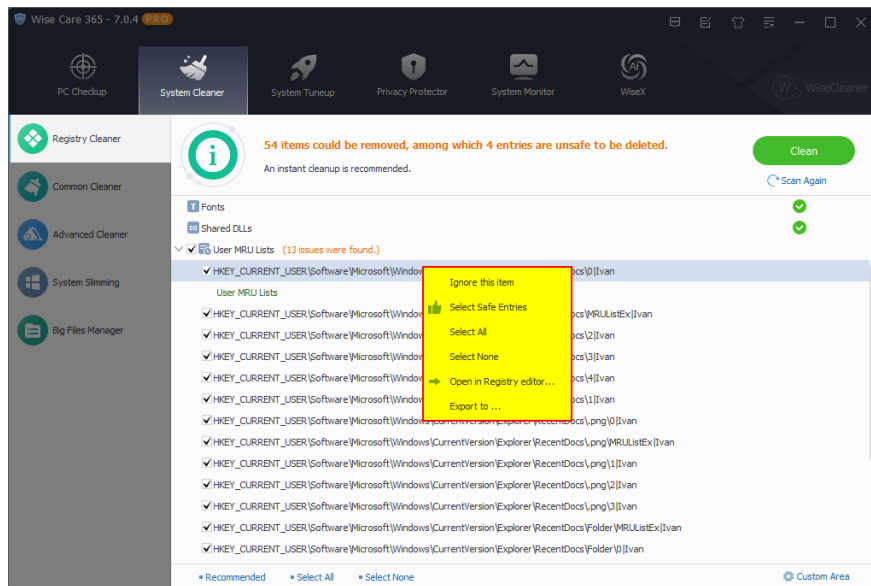


2. Scan Registry

After setting the items which need to be scanned, click the button **Scan**. After the scan is complete, expand the registry item and left-click on a result to view detailed information.



Right-click on an item, you can call out the right-click menu.



- **Ignore this item**
Add this entry to the Exclusion list, Wise Care 365 will neither scan nor clean it again until you move it from Exclusion. You can view the content of exclusion in [Menu -> Settings -> Exclusion](#).
- **Select Safe Entries**
Only select the safe registry entries to clean.
- **Select All**
Select all the entries that have been scanned out.
- **Select None**
Select none of the entries that have been scanned out.
- **Open in Registry Editor**
View the specific information of the selected entries in the registry editor.
- **Export to ...**
Export and save all the entries scanned out as a text file.

3. Recommended, Select All, Select None

There are 3 additional buttons at the bottom of the window, **Recommended**, **Select All**, **Select None**. These three buttons are only effective after the scan is completed. It cannot be clicked to use before starting the scan. Their specific function is the same as the **Select Safe Entries**, **Select All**, **Select None** in the right-click menu.

4. How to scan the registry

Wise Care 365's registry cleaner provides three methods to scan the registry: **Default Scan**, **Safe Scan**, **Deep Scan**. The Default Scan is used by default and it can be modified in [Menu -> Settings -> Cleaner](#).

Scan Method	Instructions
Default Scan (recommended)	Scan default registry location, but does not clean up unsafe registry entries
Safe Scan	Only scan and clean safe registry locations
Deep Scan	Scan all registry locations, the results listed may contain entries that cannot be safely deleted

It is not recommended for ordinary users to use the deep scan mode.

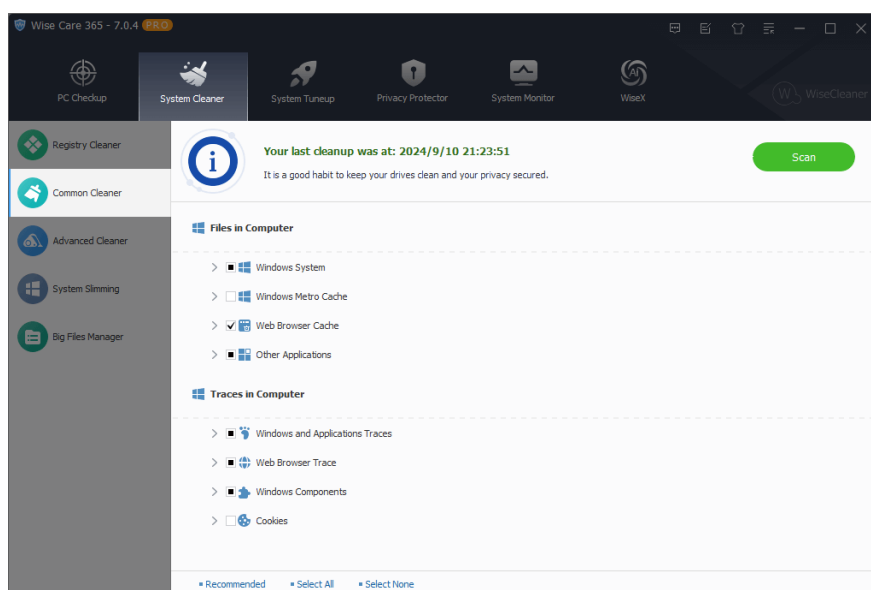

Common Cleaner

It can also be called Disk Cleaner, which can clean up useless files in the system disk, such as, log files, thumbnail cache files, Windows update files, browser cache files, browser history, cookies, browser saved passwords, temporary files created by various third-party applications (Adobe, Office, etc.), etc.

Before using the Common Cleaner to scan the system, please close the running browser first.

The files deleted by Common Cleaner cannot be recovered.



1. Select items that need to be scanned

You can left-click to select the items that need to be scanned. It is recommended to use the **Recommended** settings.

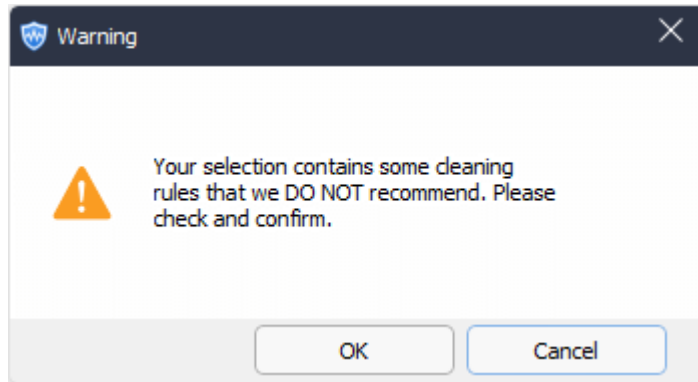
☒ , it means that **all content** under the item is selected.

☐ , it means that **part of the content** under the item is selected. Before changing it to all selected, please expand to see if the content contained in this item needs to be cleaned up.

Browser Saved Passwords in Trace in Computer -> Web Broser Trace is not recommended to scan and clean up.

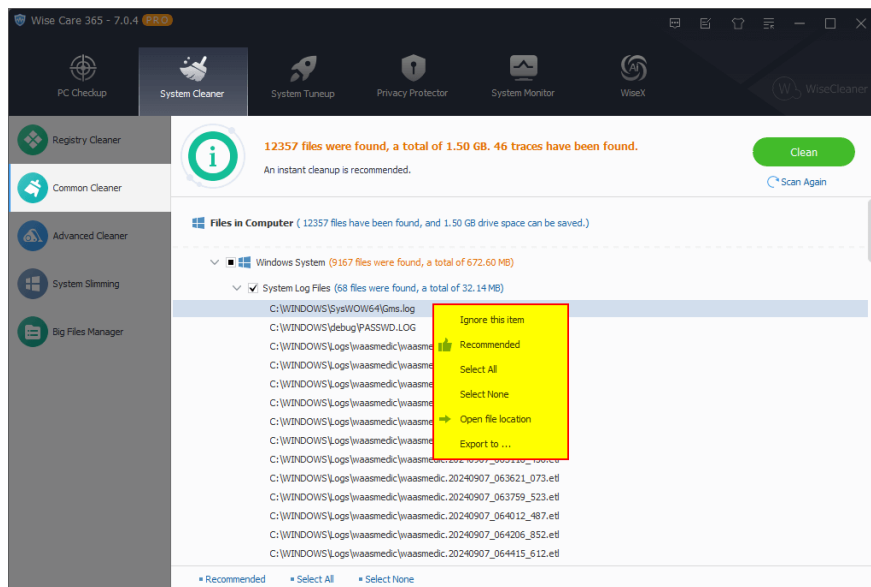
The deleted passwords can not be recovered!!!

If you click the checkbox to select all sub-items, you will receive the following prompt message and be asked to confirm again.



2. Select items that need to be deleted

After the scan is complete, you can left-click the items to expand and view the details. Right-click on an item, you can call out the right-click menu.



- **Ignore this item**

Add this file to the Exclusion list, Wise Care 365 will neither scan nor clean it again until you move it from the Exclusion list. You can review the excluded files in [Menu -> Settings -> Exclusion](#).

- **Recommended**

Only select items that we recommend to clean up.

- **Select All**

Select all items, and you will receive a prompt message and be asked to confirm again.

- **Select None**

No items are selected.

- **Open file location**

Open the location of the selected file.

- **Export to ...**

Export and save the scan results as a text file.

3. Recommended, Select All, Select None

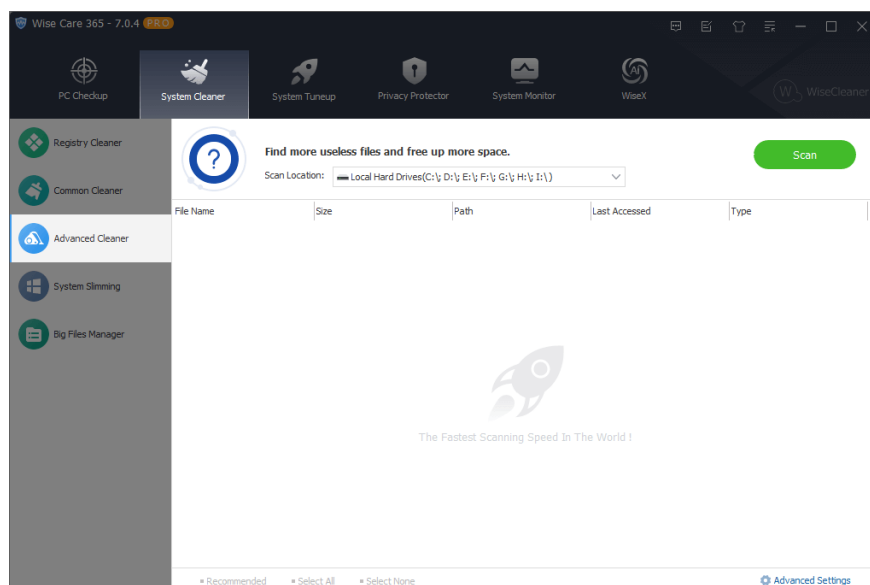
There are 3 additional buttons at the bottom of the window, **Recommended**, **Select All**, **Select None**. These three buttons are only effective after the scan is completed. It cannot be clicked to use before starting the scan. Their specific function is the same as the **Recommended**, **Select All**, **Select None** in the right-click menu.

Please use **Select All** with caution, unless you understand what the files are about to be deleted.

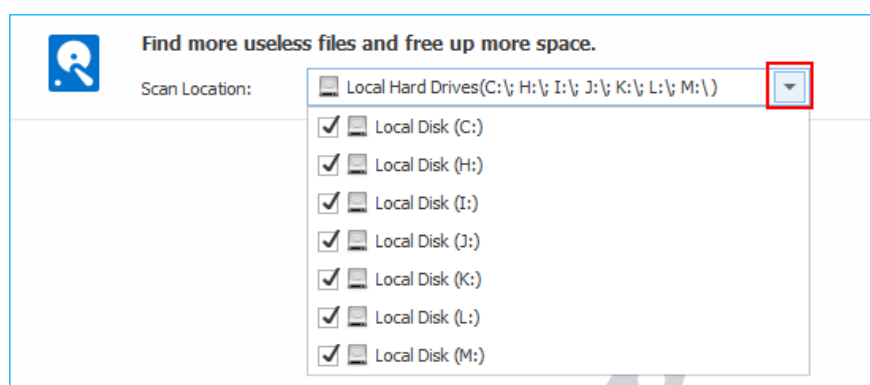
Advanced Cleaner

Scan and clean specific types of files in one or all local drives and removable disks. It also supports emptying specific folders.



1. Select the locations that need to be scanned

To the right of the scan location, click the down arrow to expand the list of drives and select the drives that need to be scanned. All available drives are selected by default.



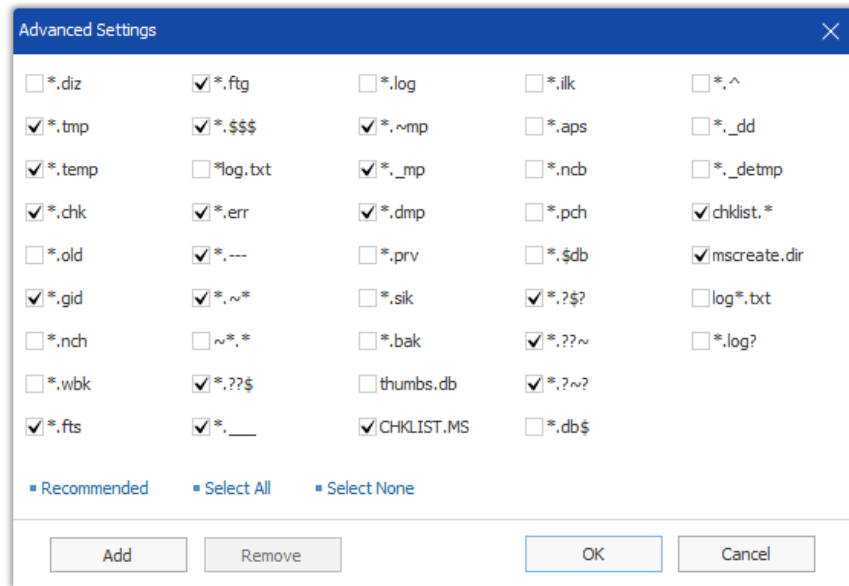
2. Select the file types that need to be scanned

Wise Care 365 finds and cleans files in the specified local drives by default: ***.tmp**, ***.temp**, ***.chk**, ***.gid**, ***.dmp**, and so on, total 21 types of files. And other 22 types of files that can be selected for cleaning. You can click the button [

Advanced Settings] in the lower right corner of the window to open the settings window and select the file type that needs to be cleaned.

At the same time, you can also click the button **[Add]** to add other file types that need to be cleaned up.




Before adding a file type that needs to be deleted, please double-check whether the file of this type can be safely deleted. After the file is deleted, it cannot be recovered.
For ordinary users, please DO NOT use the Add function! It is recommended to use the recommended settings!



3. Select the files that need to be deleted

After the scan is complete, the scan results are sorted by location by default. You can also click the title bar to reorder, for example, click the **File Name**, the list will be sorted by file name; click the **Size**, the list will be sorted by file size. The list also will be sorted by **File Path**, file **Last Accessed** time, and **File Type**.

- : It means that this file can be safely deleted.
- : It means that Wise Care 365 doesn't know whether this file can be safely deleted. It is up to the user to decide whether to delete it.
- : It indicates that this file is a type added by the user in the **Advanced Settings** or a file in a custom folder added in the [Menu -> Settings -> Cleaner](#).

Right-click on an item, you can call out the context menu.

- **Ignore this item**
Add this file to the Exclusion list, Wise Care 365 will neither scan nor clean it again. You can view the content of exclusion in [Menu -> Settings -> Exclusion](#).
- **Select All**
Select all files.
- **Select None**
Do not select any files.
- **Invert Selection**
If you just don't want to delete a few files, you can select these files first, and then use the Invert Selection function, you can quickly select other files which need to be deleted.
- **Open file location**
Open the location of the selected file.
- **Export to ...**
Export and save the scan results as a text file.

4. Custom Folder

Advanced Cleaner also supports emptying all files in the specified folder. You can add the folder which needs to be emptied in [Menu -> Settings -> Cleaner](#).

Note: This is to empty the folder, not to clean it. Advanced Cleaner will only empty all the contents of the folder!!!

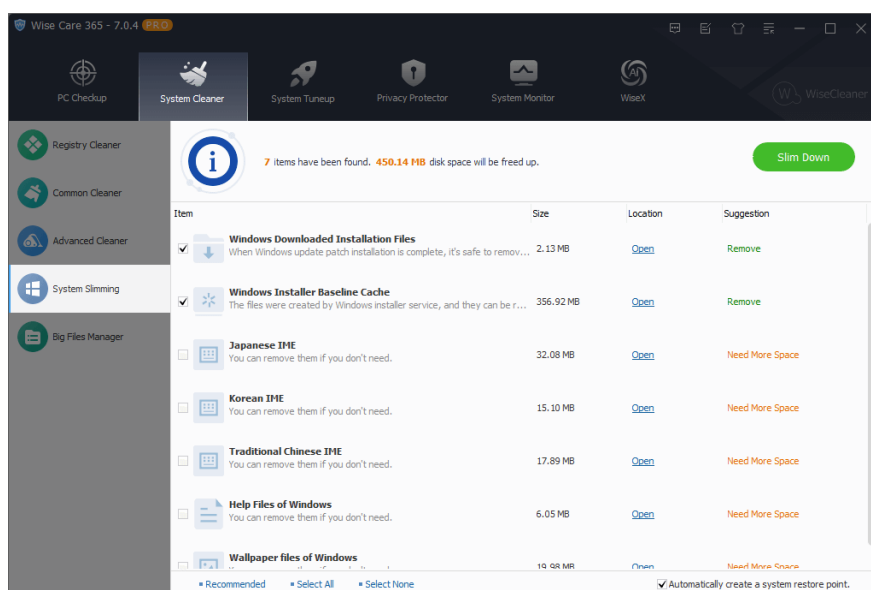

System Slimming

Without affecting the stability and security of the system, delete some specific system files to free up system disk space. Wise Care 365 can clean up the following items:

- **Windows Downloaded Installation Files (Recommended)**
After successfully installing the Windows update patches, you can safely delete the installation files.
- **Windows Installer Baseline Cache (recommended)**
The files were created by Windows installer service, and they can be removed.
- **Windows Sample Music/Pictures/Videos/Media (recommended)**
- **Wallpaper Files of Windows (Optional)**
- **Help Files of Windows (Optional)**
- **IME Files (Optional)**
IME - Input Method Editor, a Windows program that allows users to enter Asian characters through the keyboard. For example, if you delete the Japanese IME, you cannot enter Japanese characters. Therefore, unless you think you will never use this language, please keep the IME of this language.



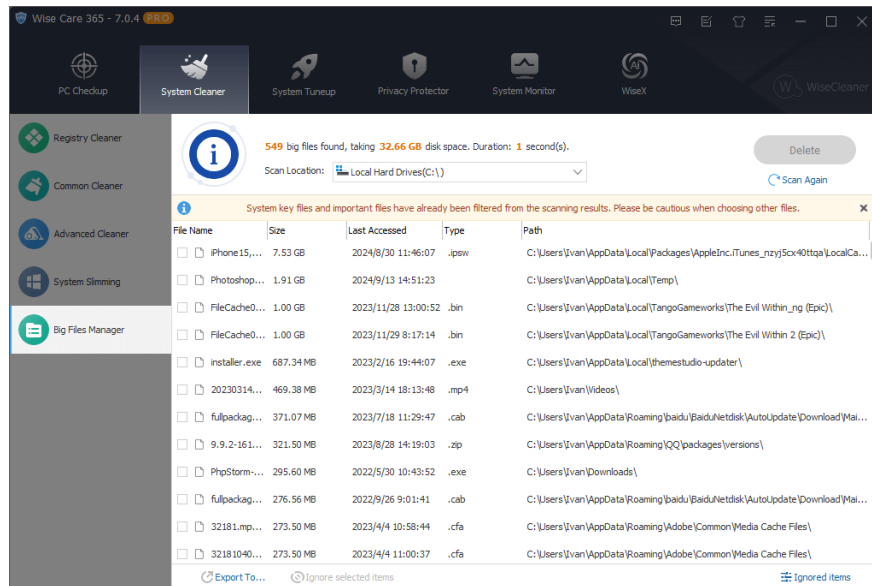
The checkbox of Automatically create a system restore point to the bottom right corner is checked by default, which allows Wise Care 365 to create a system restore point before slimming.

It is strongly recommended to turn on and create a system restore point.

Big Files Manager

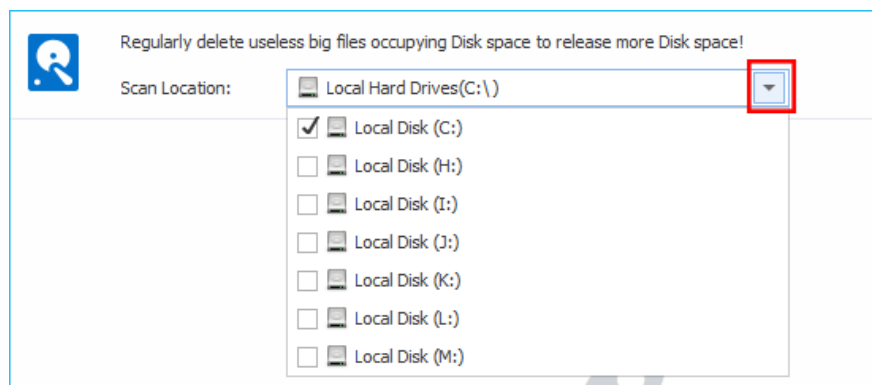
Through Big Files Manager, Wise Care 365 finds files larger than **10 MB** in the specified location. Users can choose to delete these large files to free up more free space.

Wise Care 365 just lists the files that larger than 10 MB, It's not meant that these files all can be safely deleted. It is up to the user to decide which files to delete.



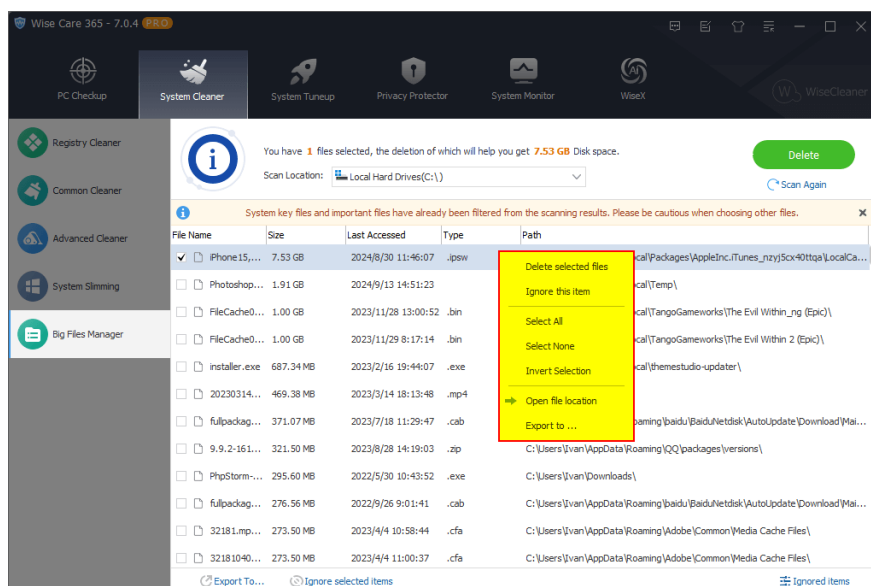
1. Select the locations that need to be scanned

To the right of the scan location, click the down arrow to expand the list of locations and select the drives need to be scanned. In default, all the drives are selected for searching.



2. Select the files that need to be deleted

After the scan is complete, the scan results are sorted by **File Size** by default. You can also click the title bar to reorder, for example, click the **File Name**, the list will be sorted by file name; click the **Size**, the list will be sorted by file size. The list also will be sorted by **File Path**, file Last **Accessed time**, and **File Type**.



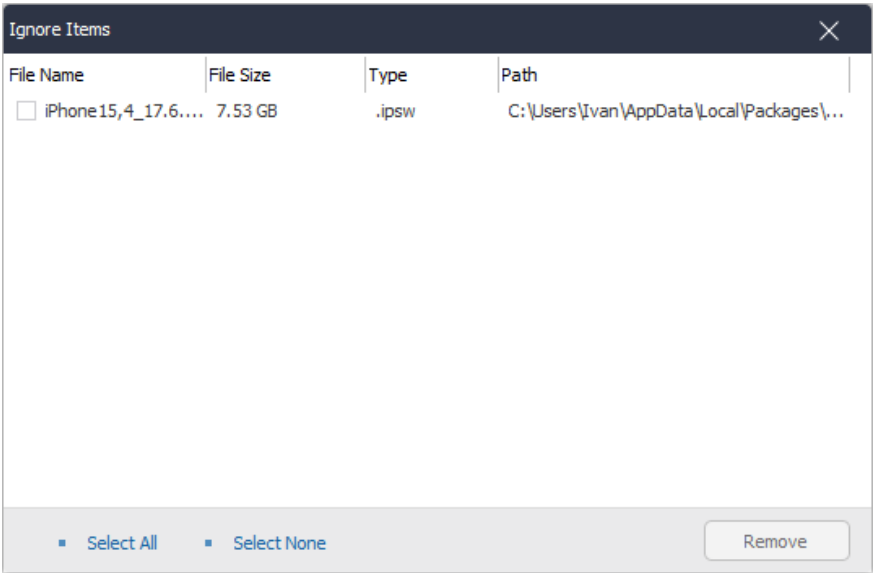

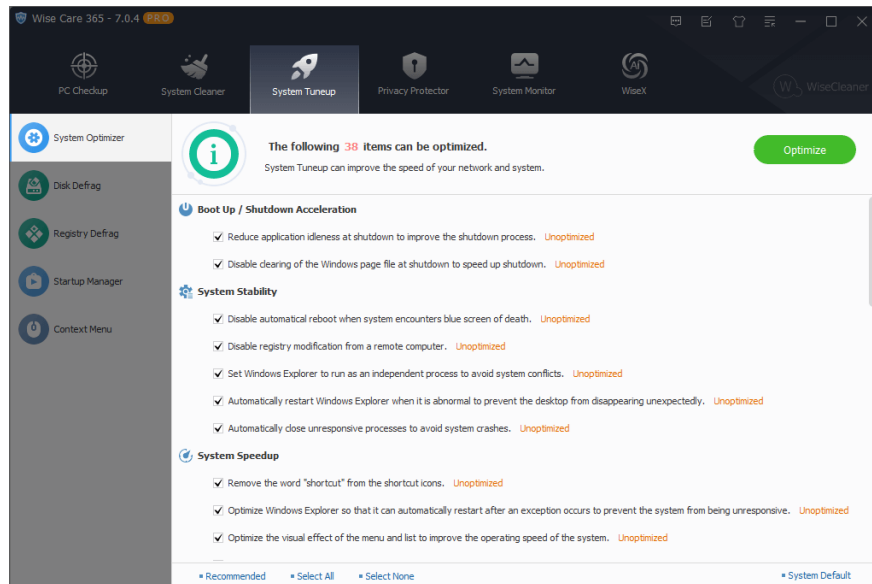

System Optimizer

System Optimizer will accelerate the system startup and shutdown speed, adjust the system stability, and improve network access speed. Some optimization items will come into effect after restart.




1. Optimize the System

If you have never optimized your system, when you open the System Optimizer tab, Wise Care 365 will list all viable optimization items in your system.

Select the items you want to optimize and then click the **Optimize** button.

2. Undo optimization


If you want to restore the optimized items, you can first use the **Select None** button at the bottom of the window, then select the items you want to restore, and then click the **System Default** button at the bottom of the window.

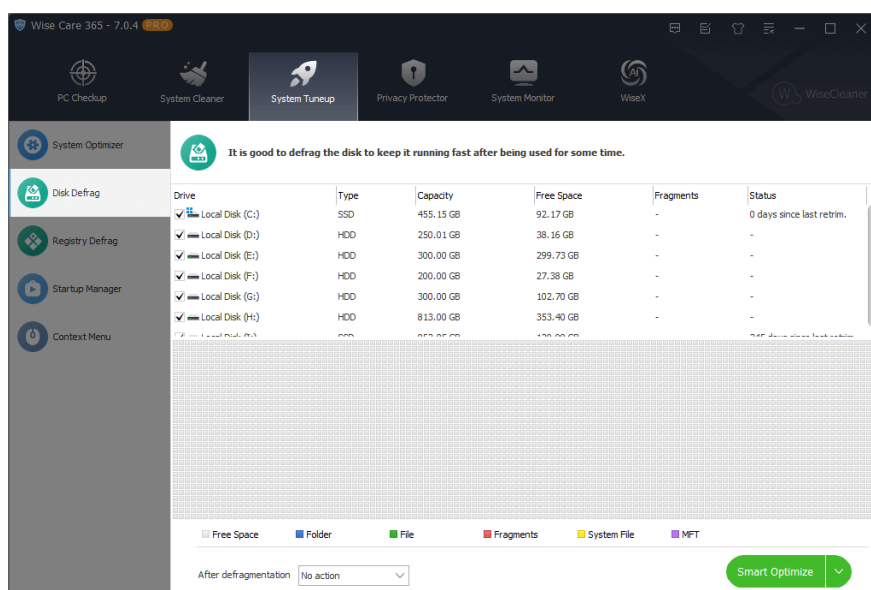

Disk Defrag

Wise Care 365 supports defragmentation and optimization of hard drives to make the file storage more compact, thereby improving system performance and running speed.

It can also use **TRIM** technology to optimize the SSD, improve the performance of the SSD, and extend the service life.

Before using disk defragmentation, please close all currently running programs to help improve the effect of defragmentation and reduce the time required for defragmentation.



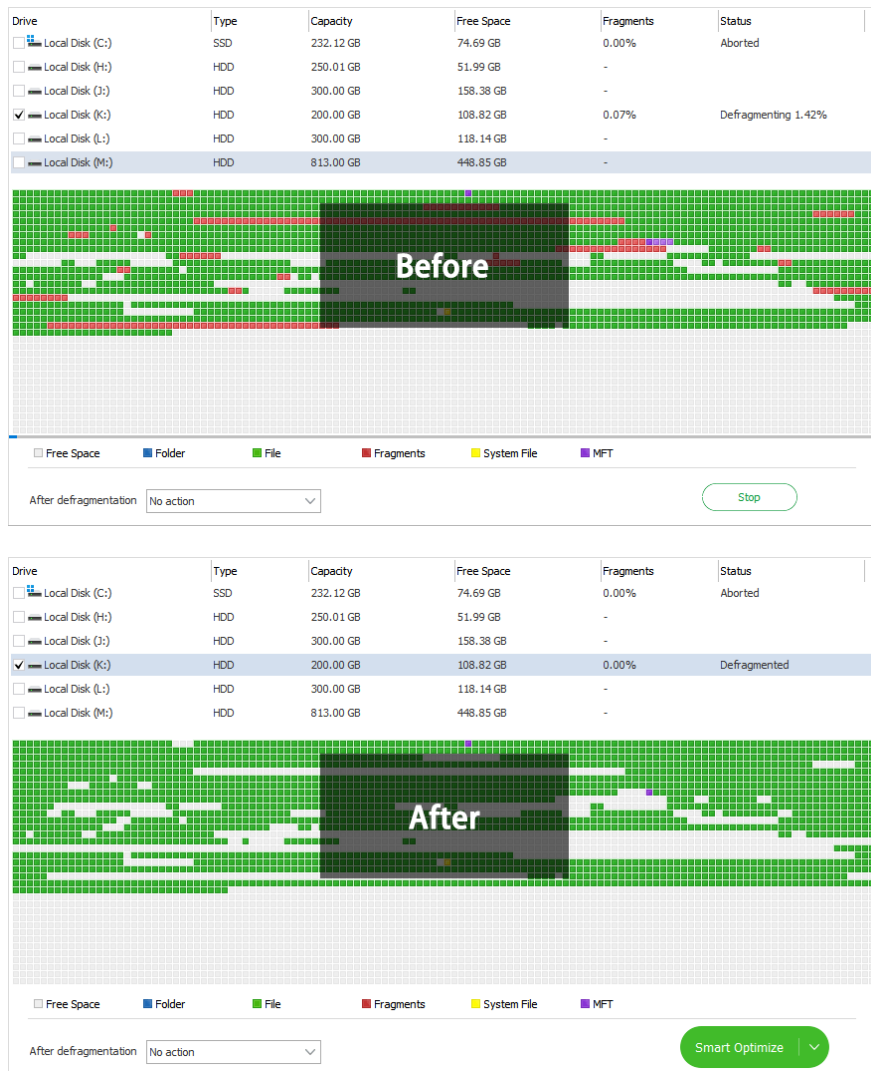
1. Smart Optimize

It will analyze the selected drive and choose the most suitable method. If the drive is an SSD, it will use TRIM. If the drive is an HDD, it will use defragmentation.

2. Defragment

This operation will concatenate fragmented files into one chunk so as to accelerate the file-reading speed and free additional available space though a little. (Files that can't be moved or are locked will be skipped.)

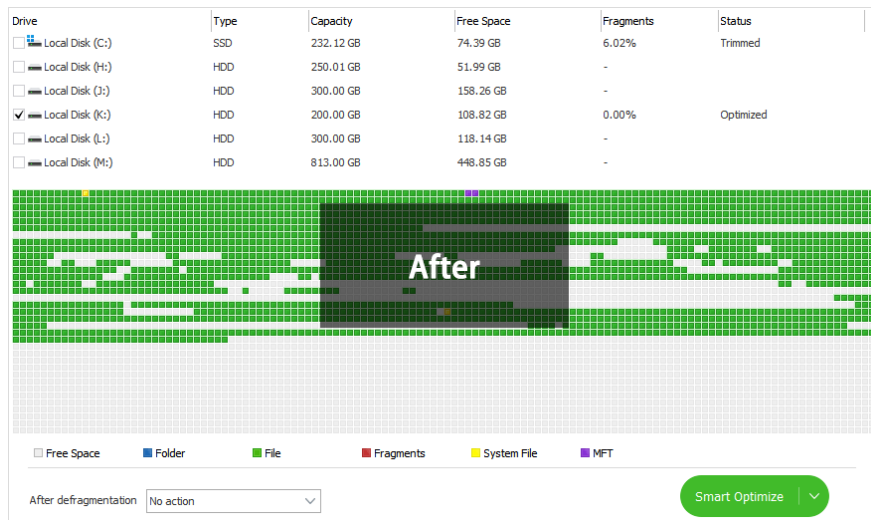
If the selected drive is an SSD, this operation will trim the drive instead of defragmenting it.



3. Optimize

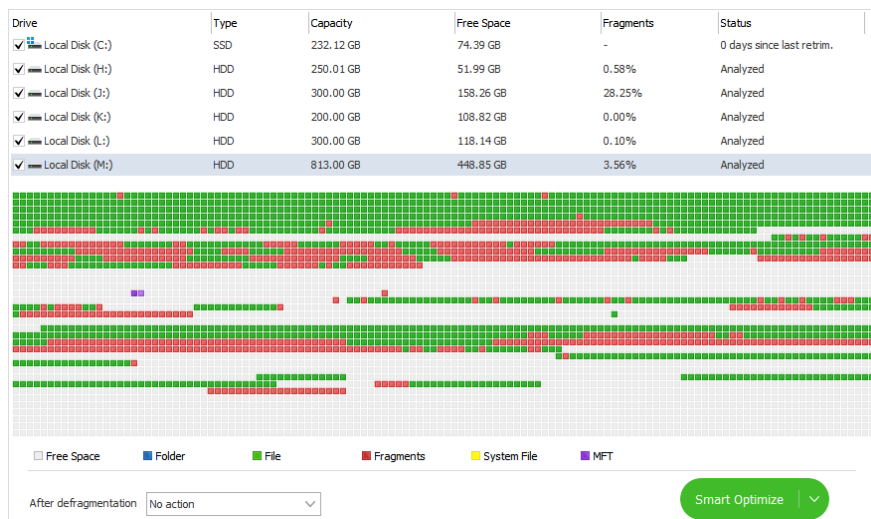
This operation will defragment fragmented files and rearrange all files (fragmented or not) to concatenate storage areas to free up disk space.

4. Analyze

As the name suggests, it just analyzes and display the fragmentation status of the selected drives. It doesnot analyze SSD.

Usually, the defragmentation and optimization time will be longer, you can click the drop-down menu to create an automatic task.

There are four tasks: **Shut Down, Sleep, Hibernate, Sign out.**

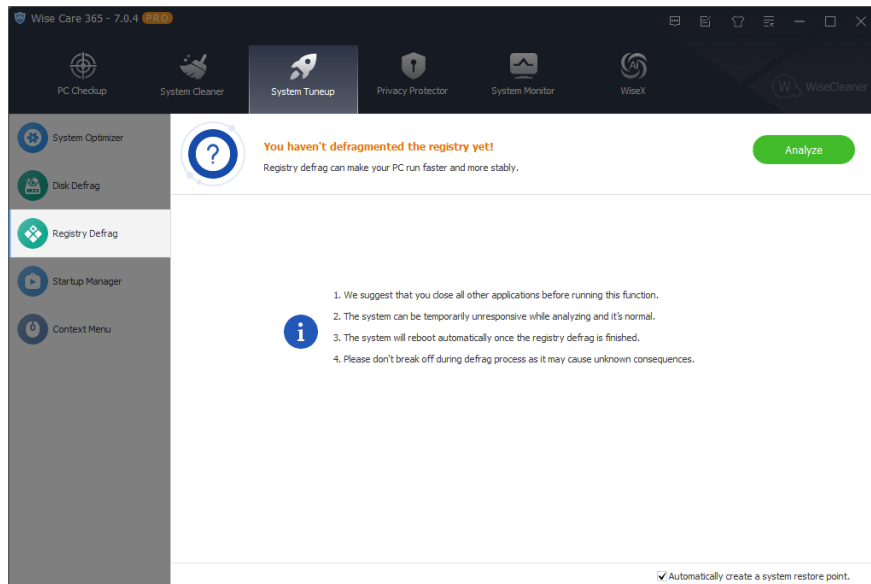

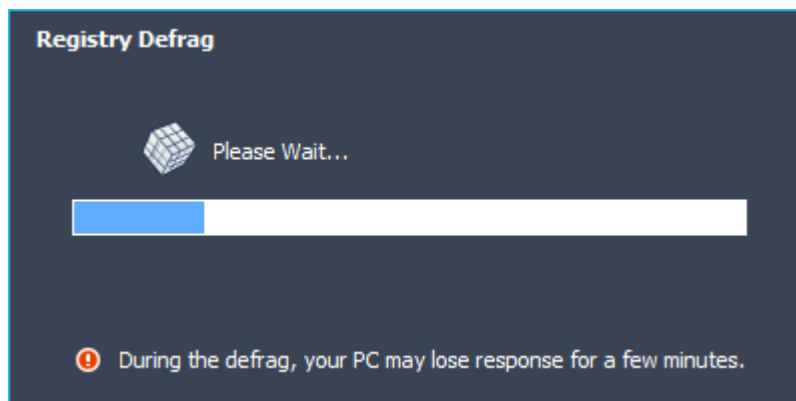
Registry Defrag

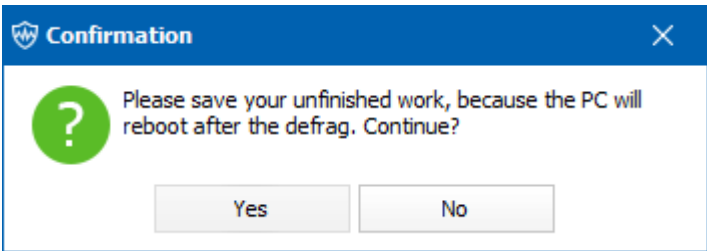

2. Defrag the registry

After the analysis is completed, click the [**Defragment**] button, Wise Care 365 will prompt the user to restart the system.

Registry defrag requires a system restart.

Do not use any method to interrupt the registry defrag, otherwise it will cause a serious system failure.

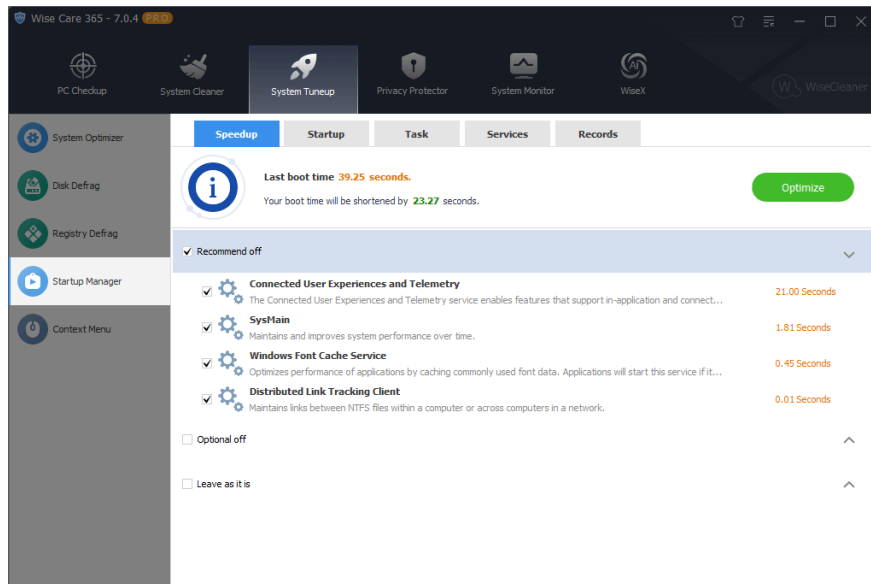

Startup Manager

When the system starts, some software will automatically run, this will slow down the system startup speed. Startup Manager can close these automatically running programs to speed up the system startup speed.

It has five tabs: **Speedup**, **Startup**, Task, **Services**, and **Records**.



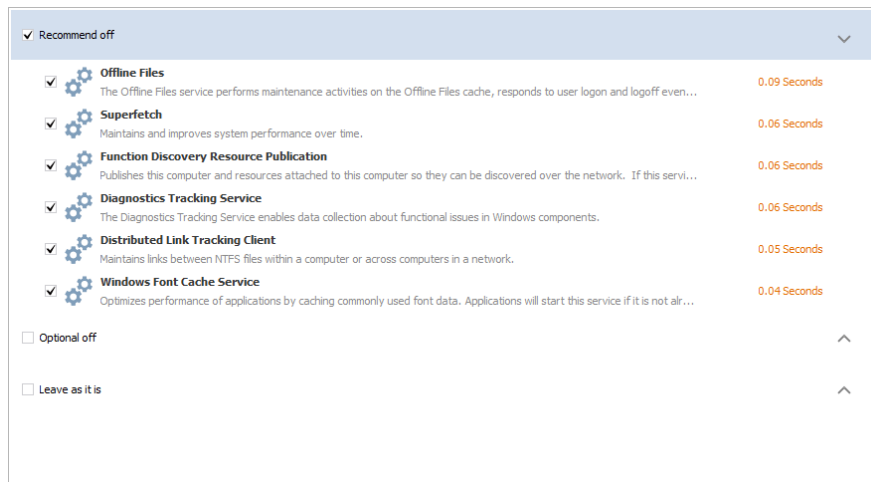
1. Speedup

The **Speedup** panel divides the programs and services that run automatically at startup into three categories: **Recommend Off**, **Optional Off**, **Leave as it is**.

After selecting the services and programs that want to be closed, click the **Optimize** button to disable the selected programs and services from running automatically when the system starts.

Recommend off

The services and programs will not affect the system's stability after being disabled.

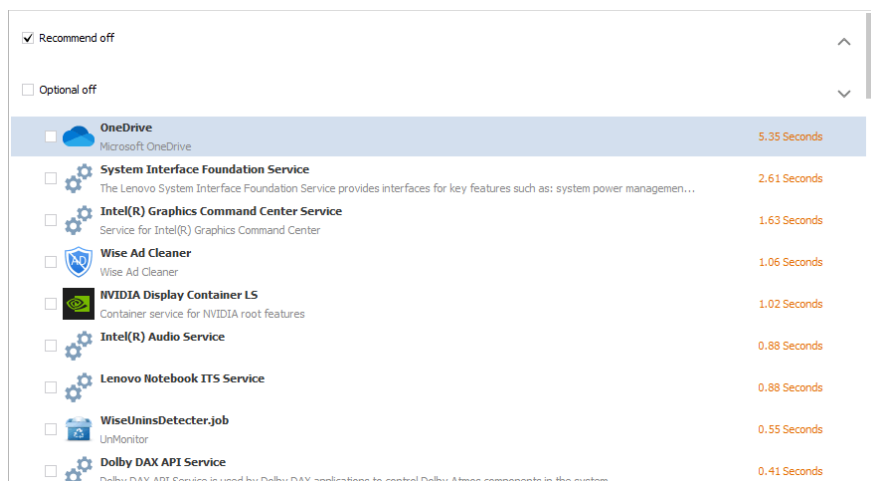


Optional off

After closing these programs or services, it may cause that some of the additional functions of the program cannot be run automatically, and need to be run manually.

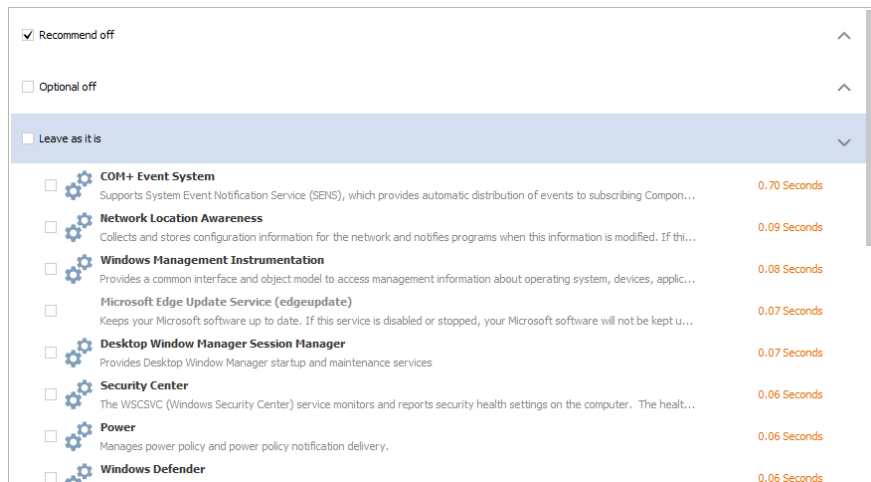
For example, OneDrive, if it does not run automatically when the system starts, its icon will not be displayed in the notification area, and files on the local and OneDrive server will not be automatically synchronized and updated. You need to start OneDrive manually.

Therefore, **Optional Off** means the programs that do not need to run automatically can be closed.



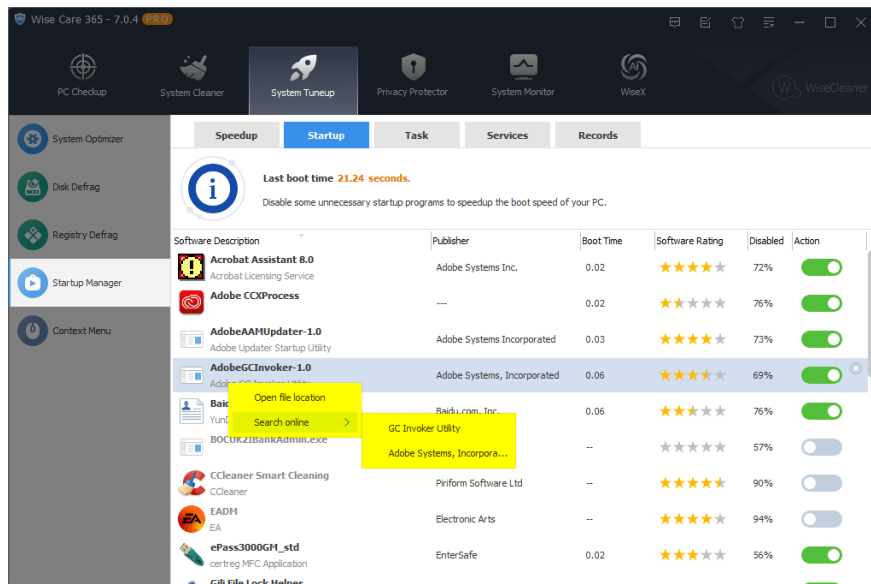

There is no need to change the current state of services and programs. Most of them are the services of Windows system. Please DO NOT optimize them unless you are sure they can be disabled.

It displays the programs that run automatically when the system starts.

Deletion does not mean to delete this program, but to remove this program from the auto-run list. Wise Care 365 cannot set this program to run automatically again. Only the reinstallation can add it to the auto-run list again.

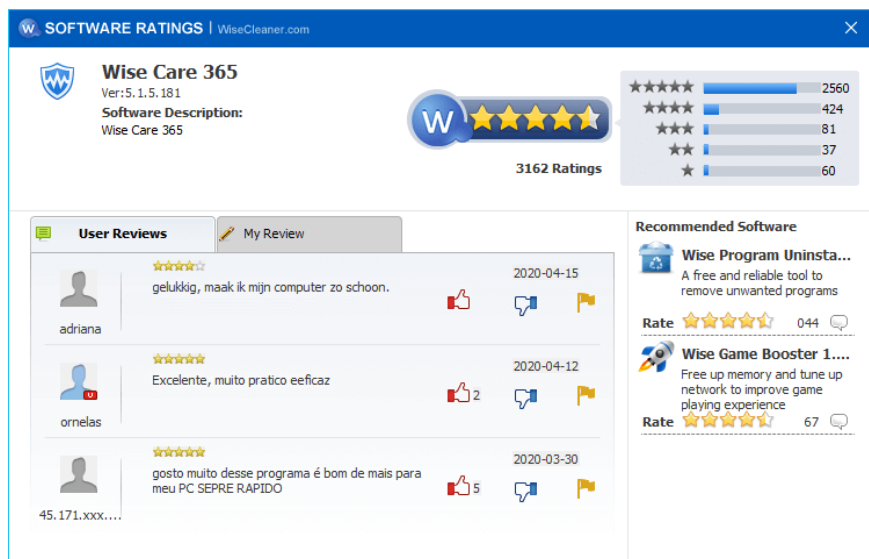

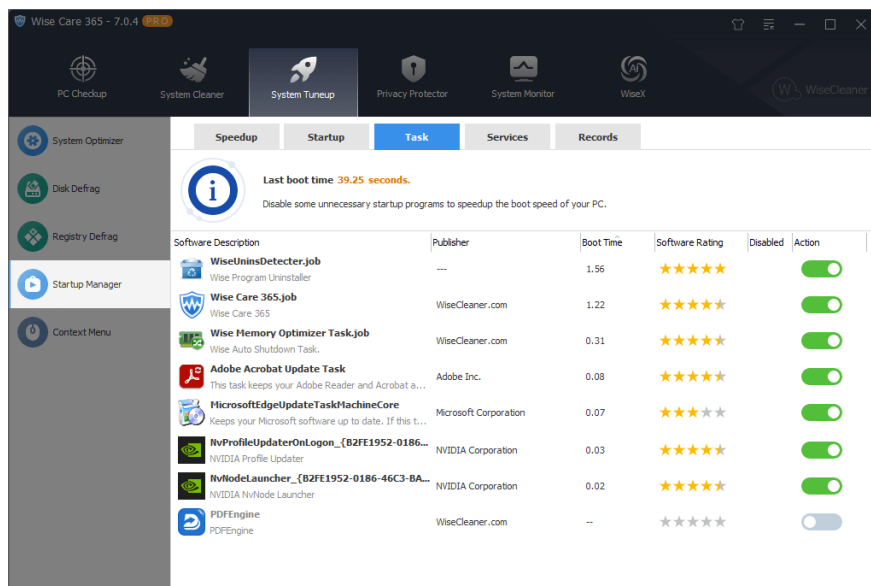

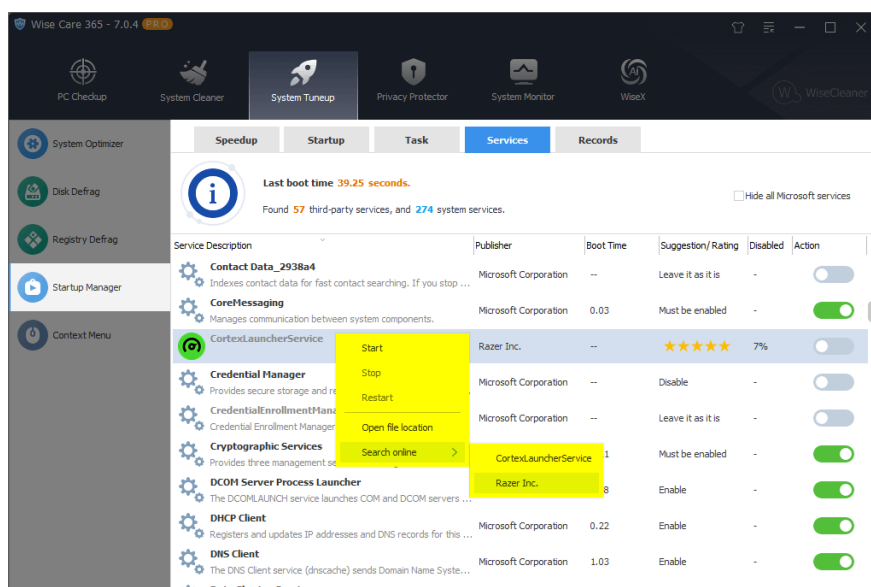


4. Services

The Services panel lists all the services that have been installed, including Windows system services and services of third-party programs. By default, it is sorted by boot time, or you can click the title bar to reorder. For example, sort by service name or publisher, etc.

If the text of the **Service Description** is highlighted, it means that the service is currently running. For example, **Dolby DAX API Service**.

If the text of the service description is gray, it means that the service is currently stopped. For example, **Network Setup Service**.

There are 4 types of suggestions for services: **Must be enabled**, **Leave it as it is**, **Enable**, **Disable**.

Hide all Microsoft services

Wise Care 365 displays all services by default. Tick [**Hide all Microsoft services**] in the upper right corner to display the services that only installed by third-party programs.

Turn OFF/ON services

Click the button behind the service to enable or disable the service to run automatically.



, It means the service will run automatically when the system starts. Click the button to change the startup type to **Manual**.



, It means the service does not run automatically when the system starts. Click the button to change the startup type to **Automatic**.

Turn off the service is to change the startup type of the service to Manual, not to disable it. To start the service, you need to restart the system to take effect.

Rating

Take a look at other users' evaluations of this automatic startup service and decide whether to prohibit automatic running. You can also submit your opinions and ratings to share with other users. Only services installed by third-party programs can be rated.

Right-click menu in Services

Right-click a service, you will see the context menu with 5 options. **Start**, **Stop**, **Restart**, **Open file location**, **Search online**.

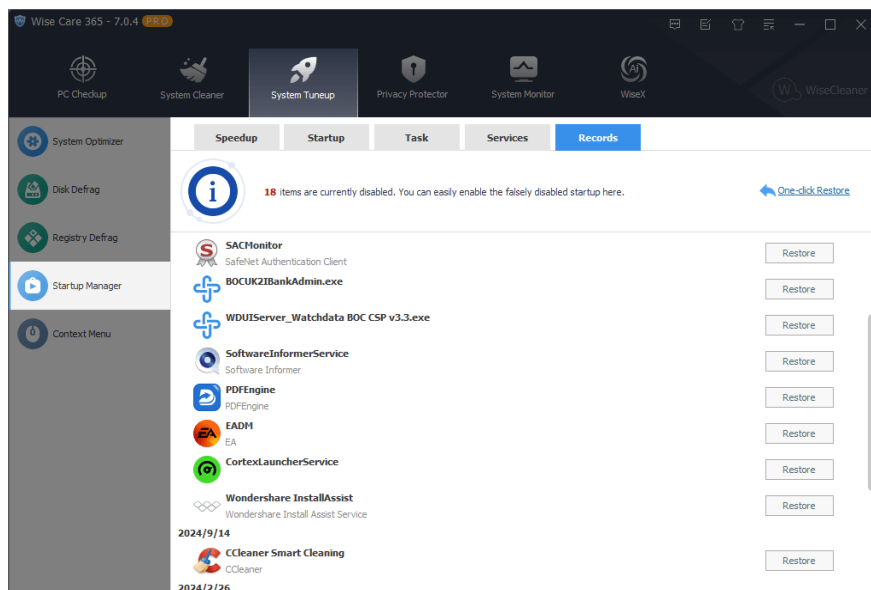

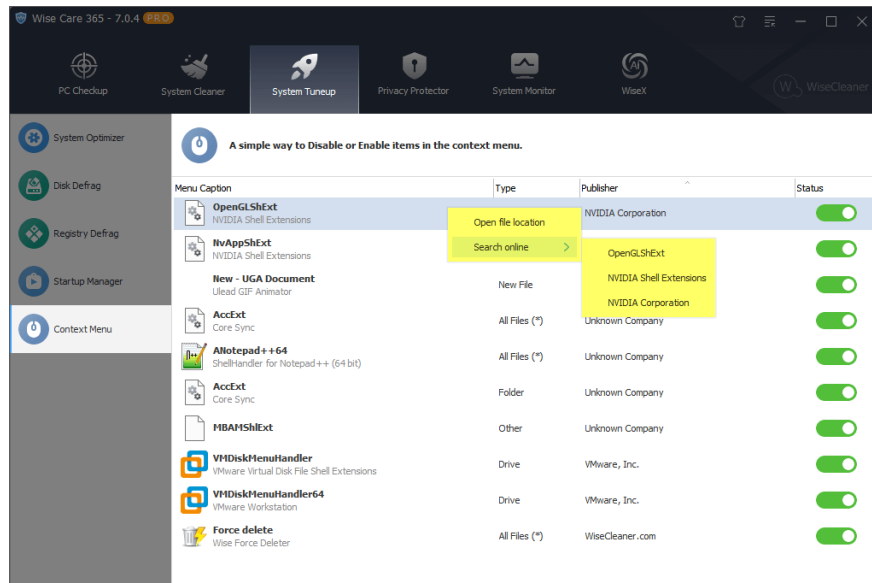

Context Menu

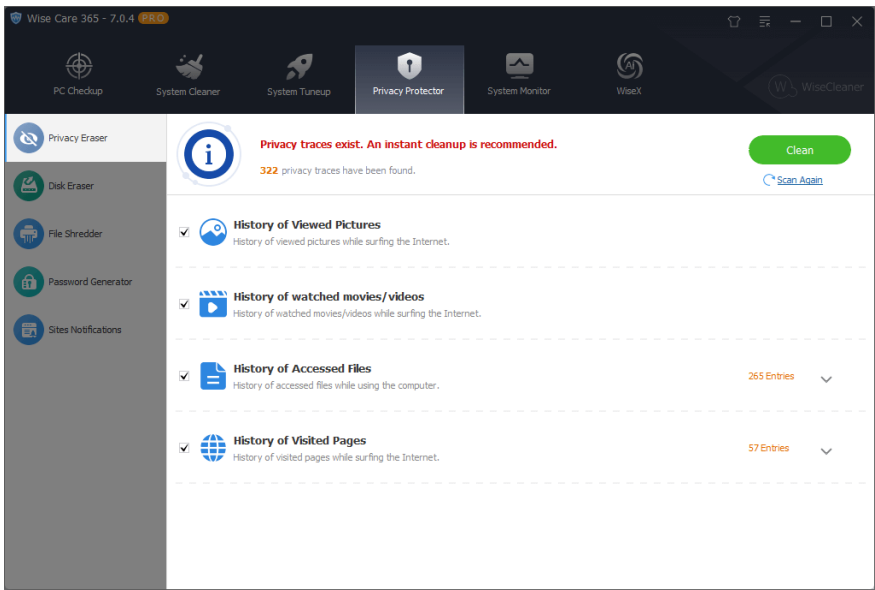

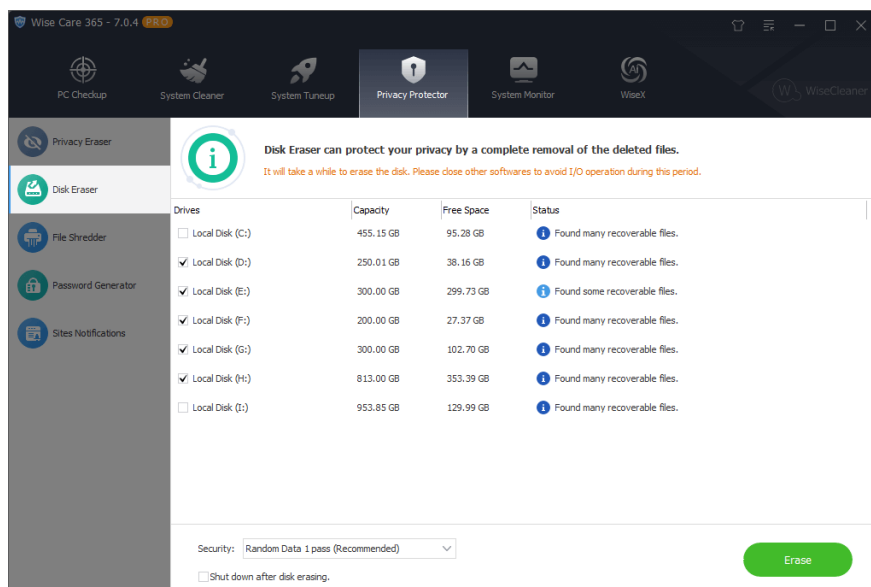

Disk Eraser


The disk eraser of Wise Care 365 fills the remaining space of the disk by creating a large number of 0-byte files, destroying the integrity of deleted files, reducing the recoverability of deleted files, and protecting your privacy.


Disk Eraser is to erase the **FREE SPACE** of the select drive, not wipe the whole drive.




1. Select the partition that needs to be erased

When you open the disk eraser panel of Wise Care 365, the program will automatically analyze all disk partitions and give corresponding suggestions.

 , It indicates that this drive has no data that can be recovered by data recovery software.

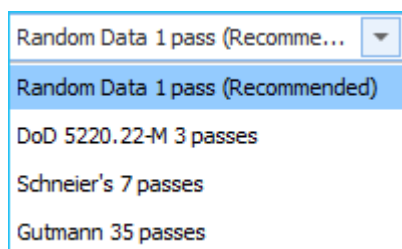
 , It indicates that there is a small amount of data in this drive that can be restored by data recovery software.

 , It indicates that there is a large amount of data in this drive that can be restored by data recovery software.

2. Choose the erasing method

Wise Care 365 will create 0-byte files to **fill the free space** of the selected drive, and then delete these 0-byte files, which is erased one pass. If you choose to erase 3 times, Wise Care 365 will repeat this operation three times.

Wise Care 365 supports 4 erasing methods: **Random Data 1 Pass**, **DoD 5220.22-M 3 passes**, **Schneier's 7 passes**, **Gutmann 35 passes**.



The more you erase the disk, the lower recoverability of the data, the higher your disk security index is, but the longer time it will take.

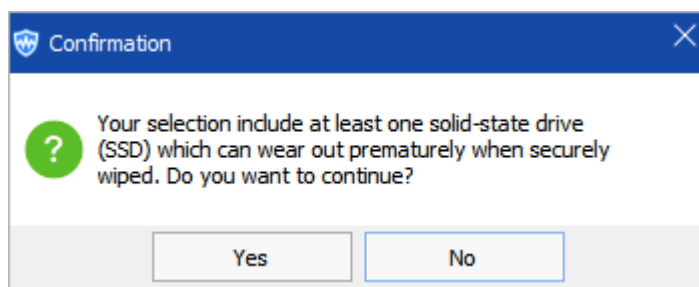
3. Start erasing disk

Before clicking the Erase button, you can check the option [**Shut down after disk erasing**], let the system shut down automatically after the erasing is completed.

Disk Eraser only analyzes NTFS drives. Please don't do any disk I/O operation while disk erasing.

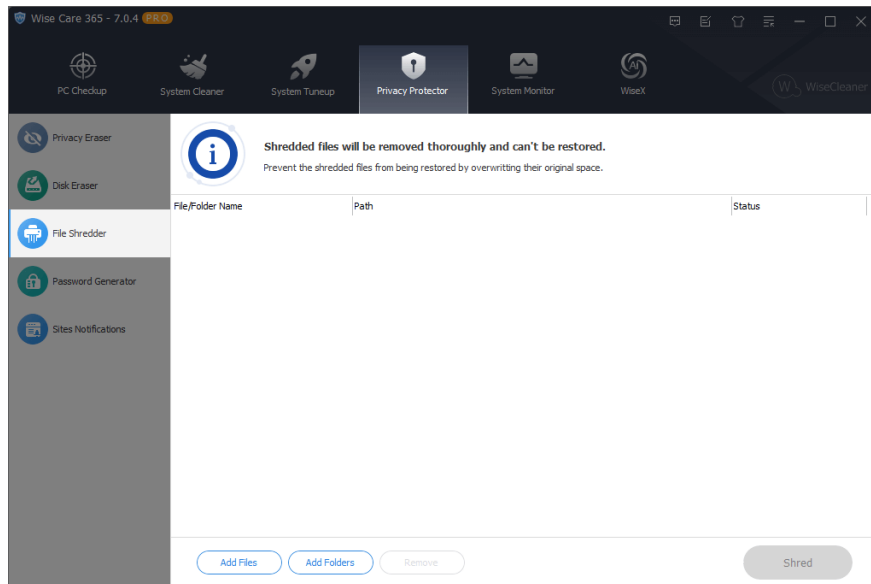

File Shredder

File Shredder deletes the files and folders, then creates 0-byte files to fill the location and reduce the recoverability of the deleted files and folders.



1. Add files or folders

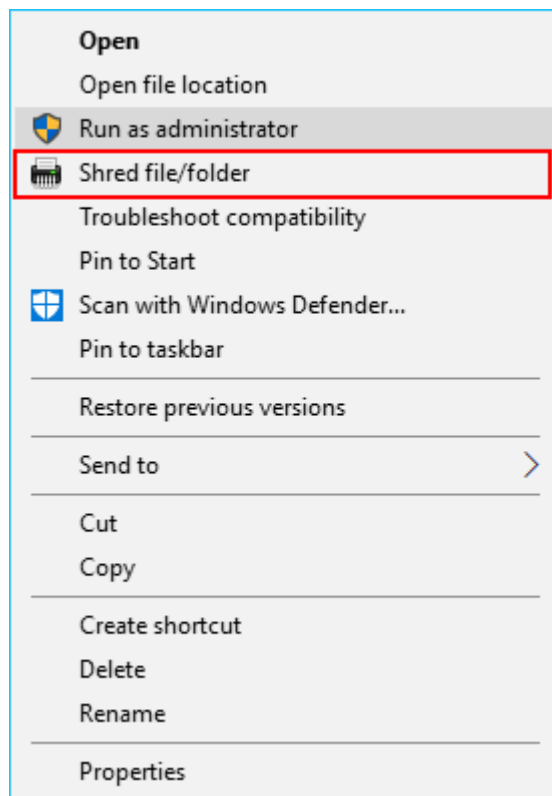

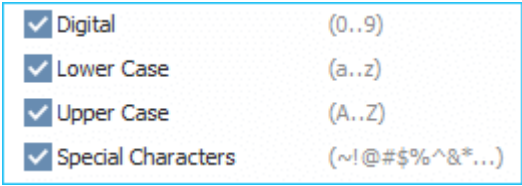

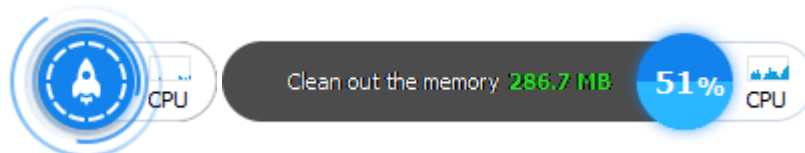

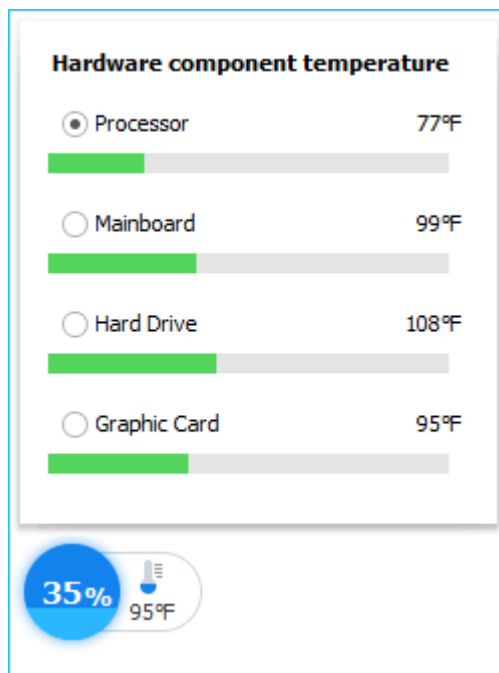

Wise Protection

Its original name is System Protection, protects the registry's key locations in real-time, effectively prevents applications from changing the homepage settings of the IE browser, prevents applications from adding to the system startup items, prevents programs from changing the default browser, and prevents advertising windows of applications from popping up.

1. Turn ON/OFF Protection

The switch of system protection is on the right side of the PC Checkup panel, above the Utilities area.

2. Notification of system protection

Once this option is selected, Wise Care 365 will no longer monitor this registry key. When other programs modify this registry key, Wise Care 365 will not pop up a prompt message.

3. Set up Wise Protection

All protections are enabled by default. But you can change it in **Menu - Settings - System Protect**.

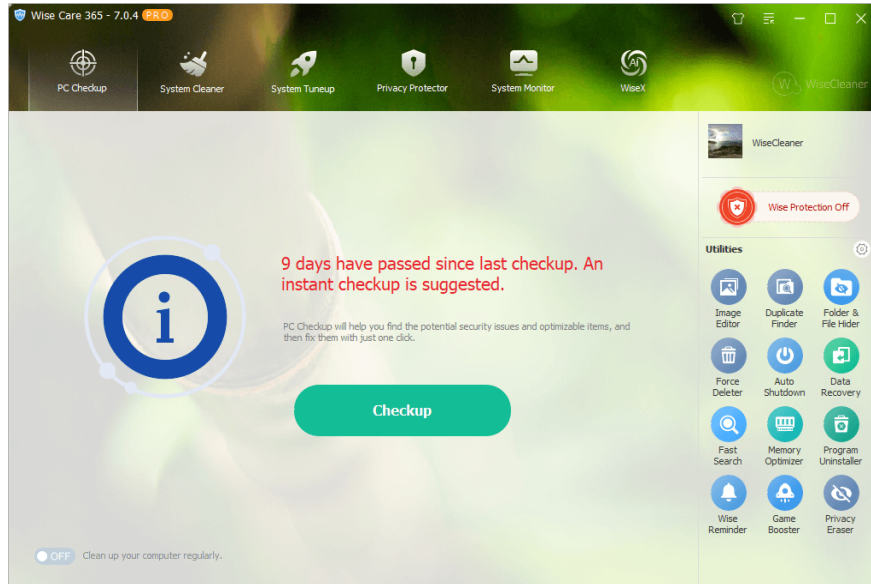
1. Use the official theme

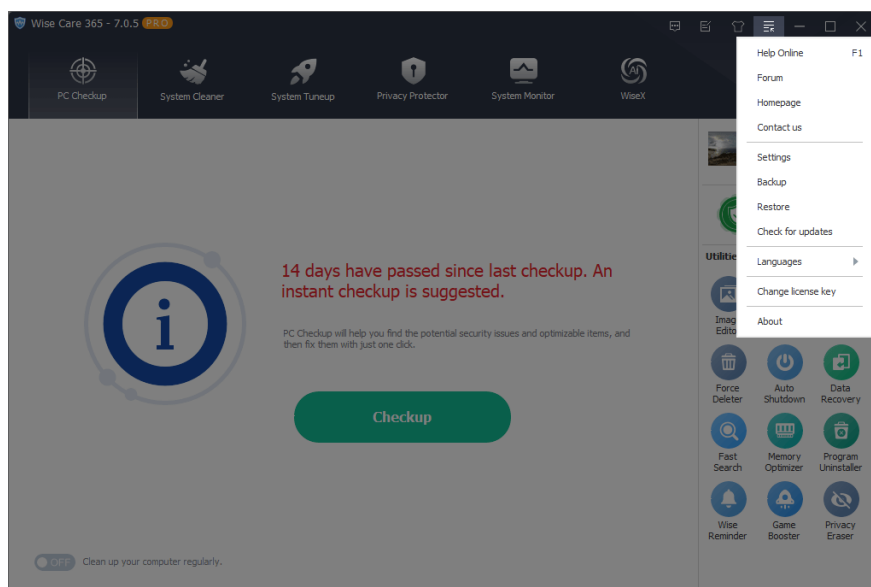

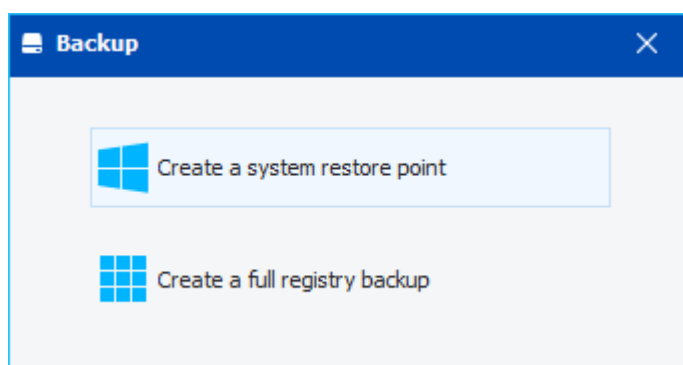
Menu

The menu of Wise Care 365 provides various functions, such as **Help Online**, **Forum**, **Homepage**, **Contact us**, **Settings**, **Backup**, **Restore**, **Check for updates**, **Languages**, **Register (Change license key)**, **About**.



1. Backup

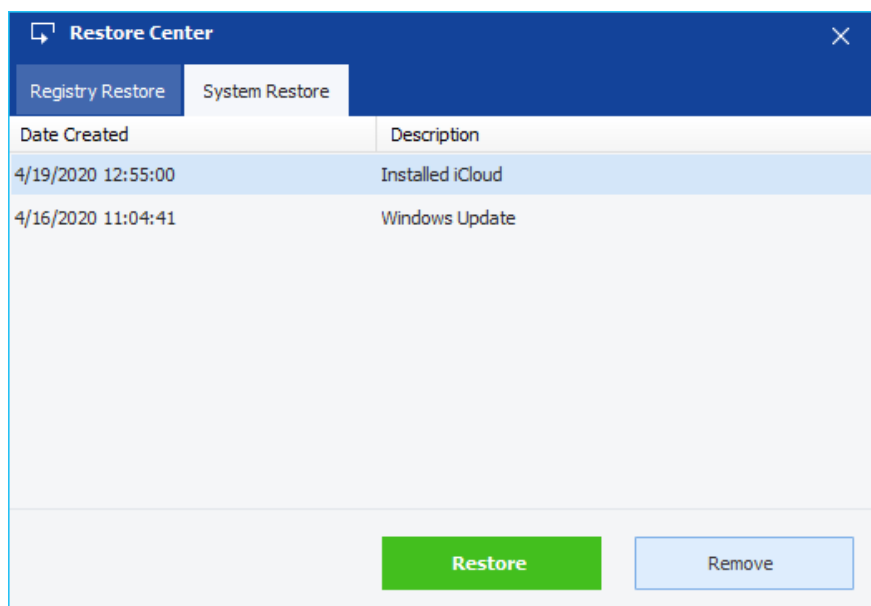
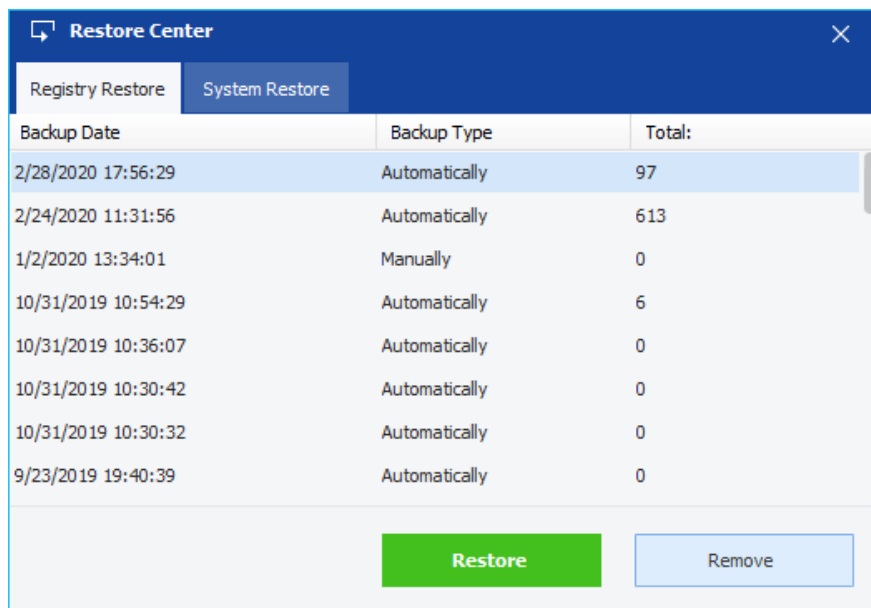
Wise Care 365 supports creating a system restore points and backup the full registry.



2. Restore

Wise Care 365 backs up the registry entries automatically before cleaning. You can restore the deleted registry entries from the Restore center if a certain program that doesn't run properly after cleaning.

You can also use the system restore point to restore the system to an earlier state.



3. Check for updates

Wise Care 365 detects new versions automatically, you can set the frequency of checking in [Settings -> General](#). You can also click this option [**Check for updates**] to check now.

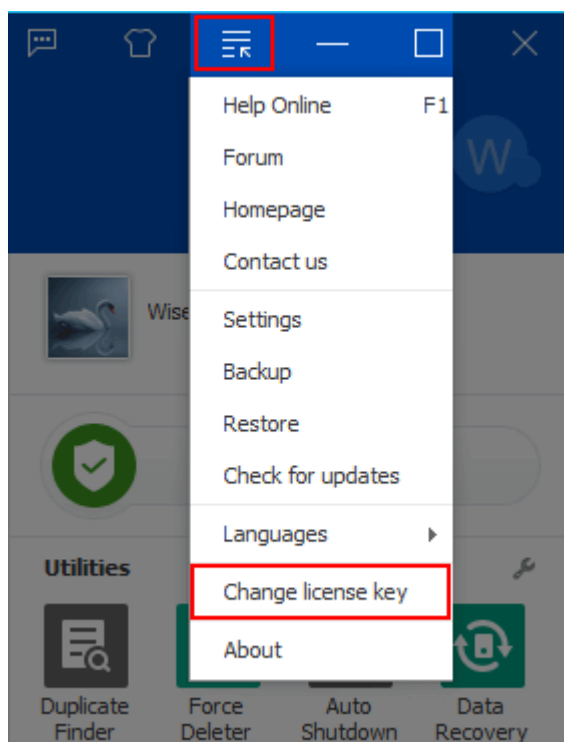
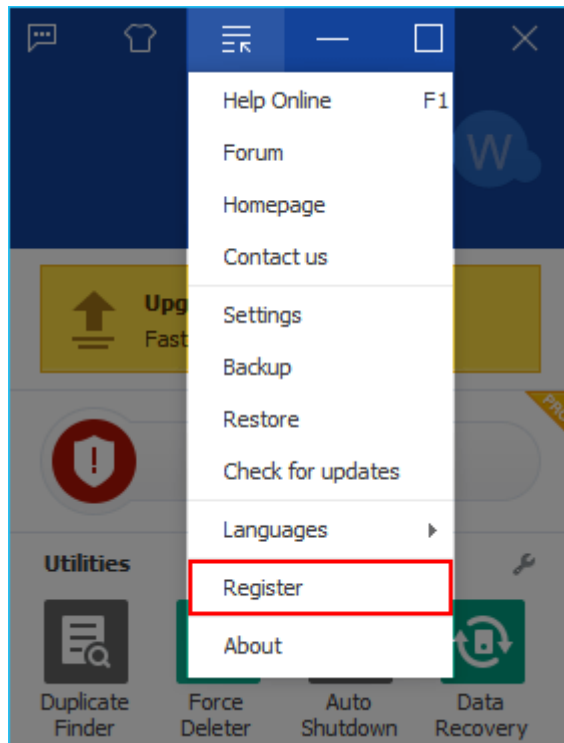
4. Languages

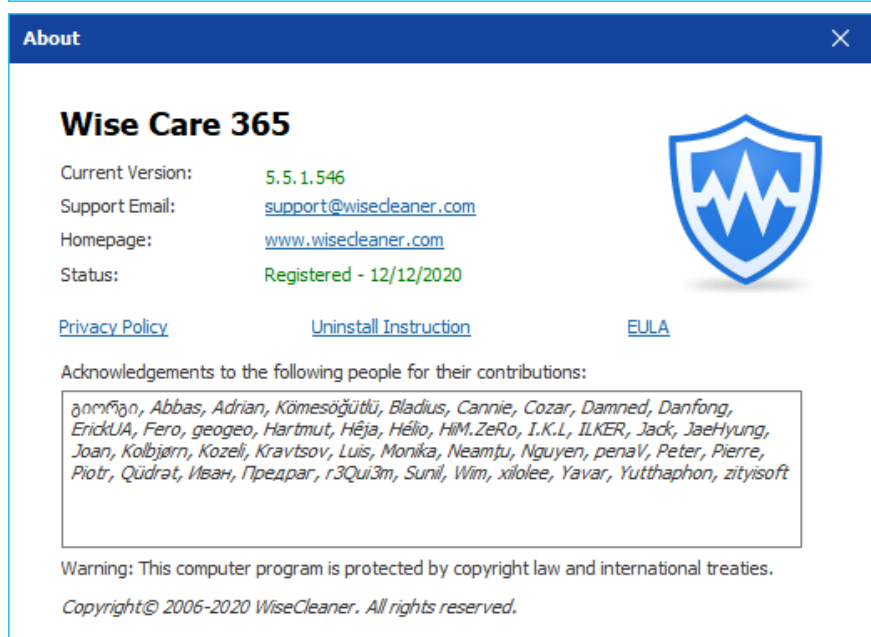
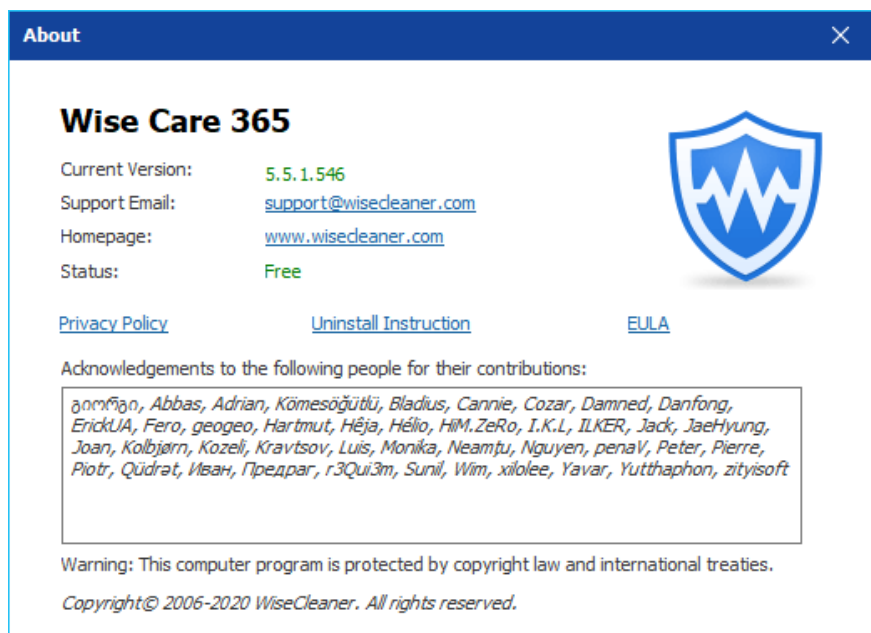
If the current version is Free, it will be displayed as [**Register**], and you can activate Wise Care 365 to Pro version by entering a license key in the registration window.

6. About

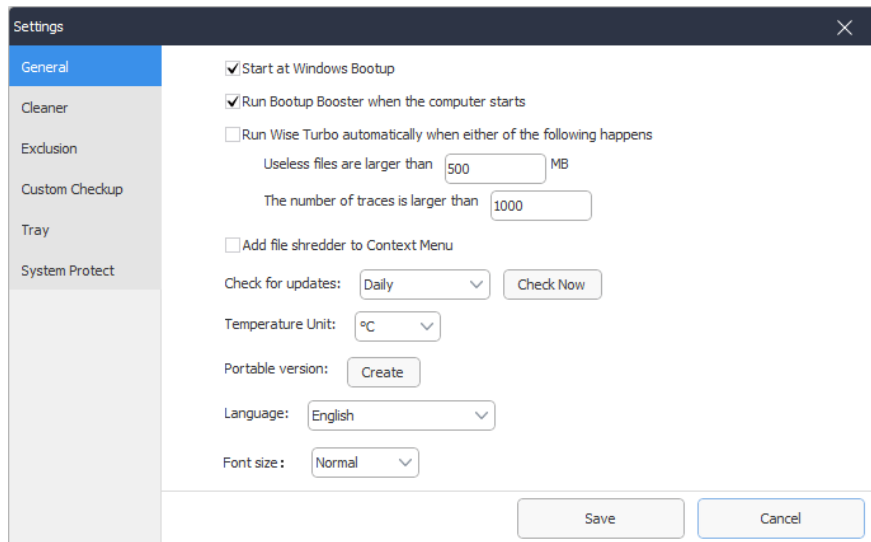

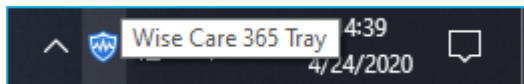

1. General

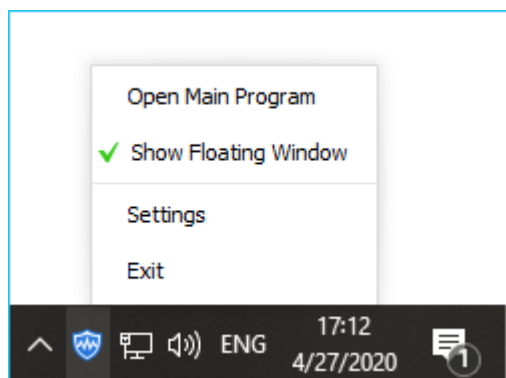


1.1 Start at Windows Bootup

The default is checked. Wise Care 365 Tray program will run automatically when the system starts.



Right-click on the tray icon can call out the context menu, it has 4 options.



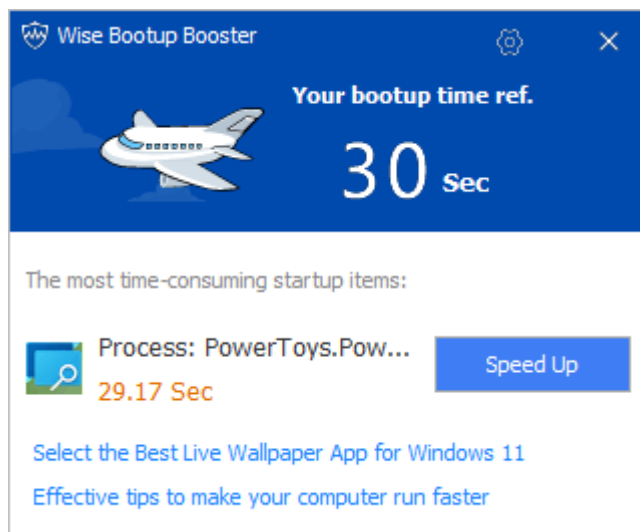
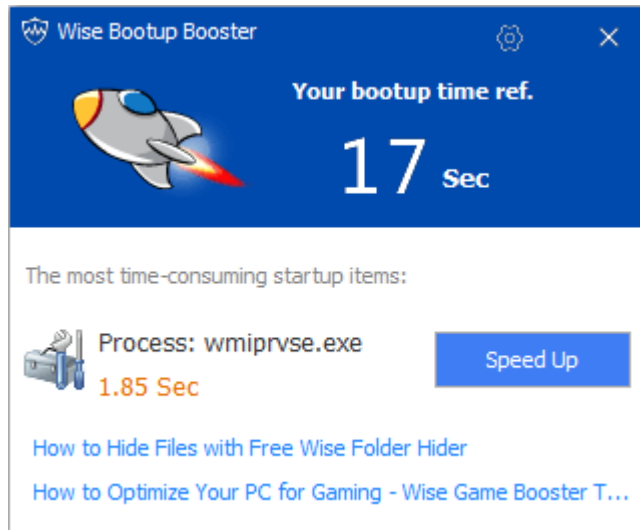
- **Open Main Program**
Open Wise Care 365 main window.
- **Show Floating Window**
Display the floating window.
- **Settings**
Open the settings window of Wise Care 365.

- **Exit**

Close the tray program. If Wise Care 365 is now running, this will also close Wise Care 365.

1.2 Run Bootup Booster when the computer starts

The default state is selected. Wise Boot Booster automatically runs when the Windows system starts, calculates, and displays the time spent on this startup and the most time-consuming item (process, or service).



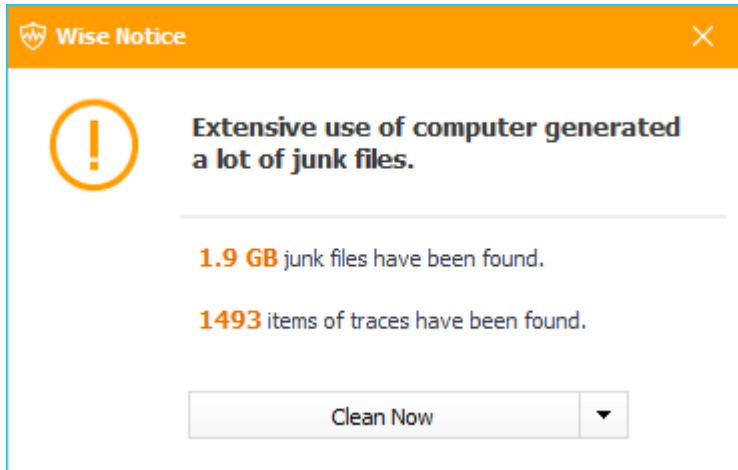
Misconception: $30 - 29.17 = 0.83$

Some users misunderstand bootup time as the sum of time consumed by all automatically running processes and services. It is taken for granted that the current bootup time minus the time consumed by a certain process or service equals the new bootup time. This isn't the case.

Disabling or deleting processes or services that consume a lot of time during startup can indeed improve the system's startup speed significantly. However, this does not mean that the startup time will be reduced by exactly the amount of time these processes or services were taking.

1.3 Run Wise Turbo automatically

The default status is checked. Wise Turbo will check the system periodically. You will see a prompt message in the lower right corner of the desktop coming from Wise Turbo when the size of junk files or the number of traces exceeds the threshold.



Wise Care 365 runs Wise Turbo twice a day. The first time, 5 minutes after the computer starts. The second time is at the set task time (the default is the time when Wise Care 365 was first installed).

The drop-down menu of the Clean Now button provides the other 2 options:

Remind Later, Never Show again.

- **Clean Now**

If you click the **Clean Now** button, it will open the Wise Care 365 main window, scan, and clean the system automatically.

- **Remind Later**

This option will close the Wise Notice window and displays it again when the next task runs.

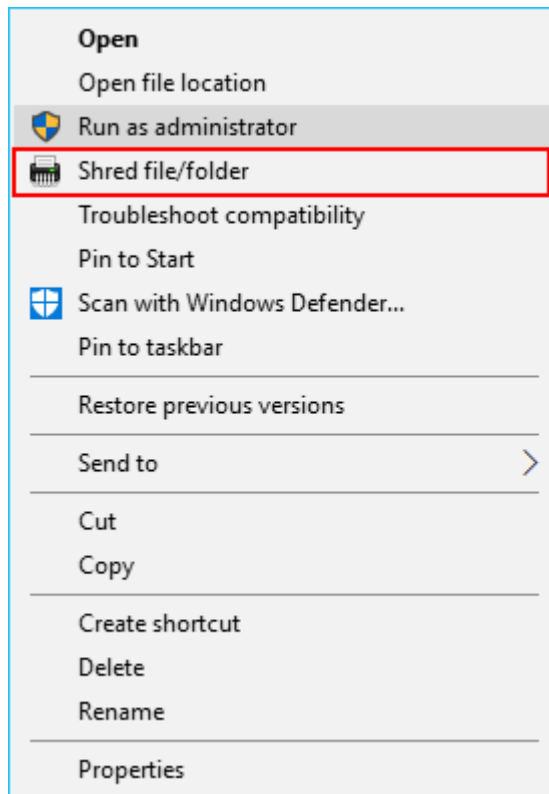
- **Never Show Again**

If you choose this option, it will close the window and uncheck the option **Run Wise Turbo automatically when either of the following happens.**

The file size and the number of traces only need to meet one of them, and Wise Turbo will prompt you to clean it up.

1.4 Add shred file/folder to Context Menu

The default is checked. Turn on or off the display at Context Menu.



1.5 Check for updates

Set the frequency of automatically checking for new versions of Wise Care 365.

1.6 Temperature Unit

Set the temperature unit displayed in Wise Care 365, such as hardware temperature and weather temperature.

1.7 Portable Version

Click the [**Make Portable Version**] button can create Wise Care 365 portable version, store the portable version files on a USB drive, or removable disk, you can run Wise Care 365 on other computers without installation.

The portable version is a Free version, it does not store your registration information.

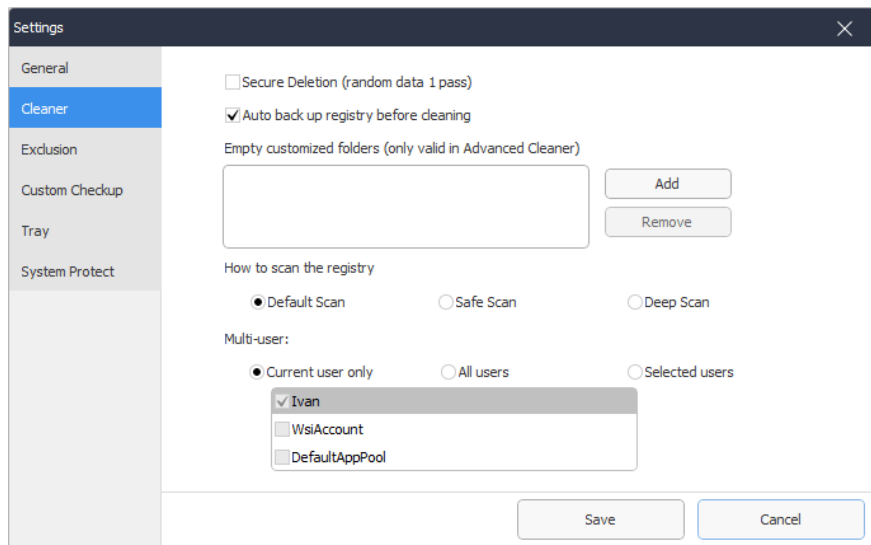
1.8 Language

Same as [Languages in the menu](#), change the display language of Wise Care 365.

1.9 Font size

Provides three font sizes: **Normal**, **Large**, and **Larger**.

2. Cleaner



2.1 Secure Deletion

If you select this option, Wise Care 365 will erase the location where the files are stored after cleaning, reducing the probability of recovering the deleted files, and improving privacy security. It is the same as the file shredding function, erased one pass.

Secure Deletion only effective in PC Checkup, Common Cleaner (not including emptying Recycle Bin), and Advanced Cleaner.
Secure Deletion is slower than normal deletion.

2.2 Auto registry backup when cleaning

The default state is selected. Before cleaning, Wise Care 365 will automatically back up the registry keys that will be deleted.

It is not recommended to turn off this feature!!!

2.3 Custom folder to empty

Add folders that need to be automatically emptied to the list. When you run Advanced Cleanup, Wise Care 365 will automatically delete all the files in the folder.

Please use this function with caution. Once the files in the folder are deleted, they cannot be recovered!!!
It is only valid in Advanced Cleaner.

2.4 How to scan the registry

Wise Care 365 provides three different ways to scan the registry: **Default Scan**, **Safe Scan**, **Deep Scan**. Default Scan is used by default.

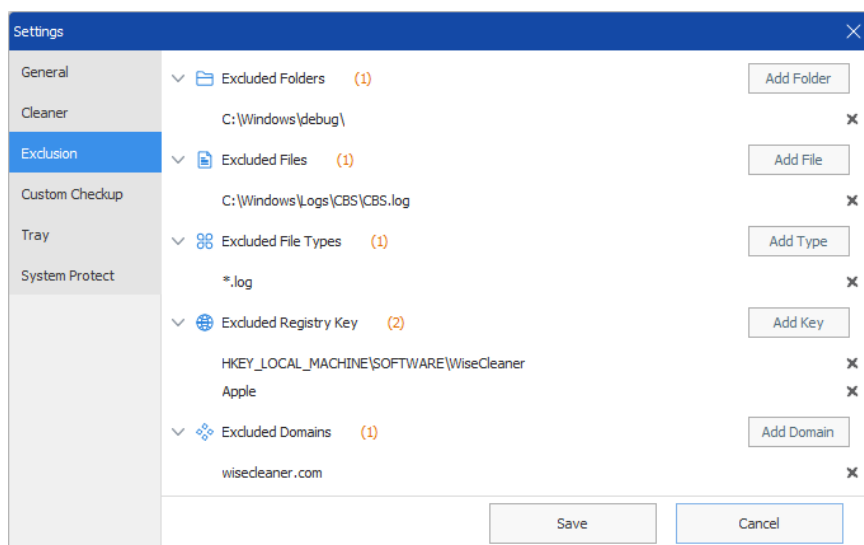
It is not recommended for ordinary users to use the Deep Scan!!!

2.5 Multi-user

Wise Care 365 supports scanning the registry files of different accounts under the current system. By default, only the registry files of the current user will be scanned.

3. Exclusion

If you want to keep a file, folder, registry entry, cookie, please add it to the exclusion list, and then Wise care 365 will no longer scan the items in the exclusion list.

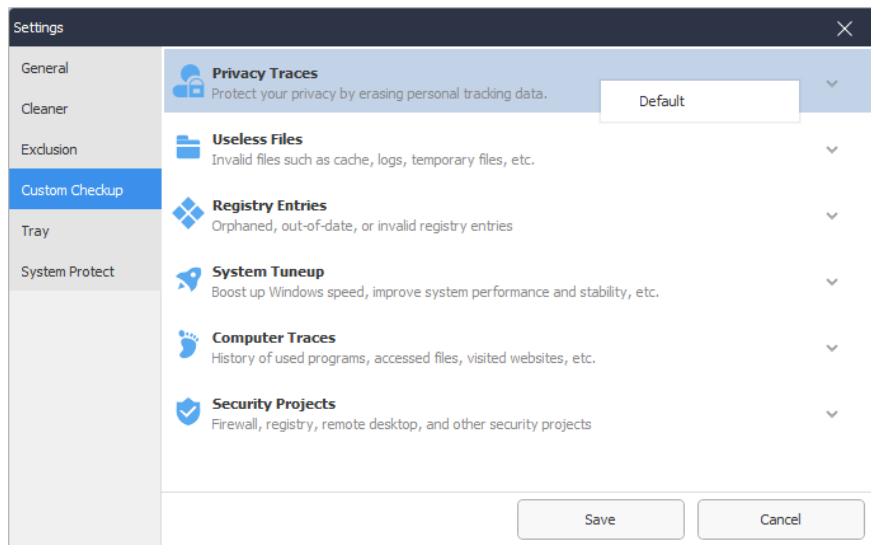


There are two ways to add items to the exclusion list. The first method is to right-click the item in the scan results and select "Ignore this item." The second method is to use the [**Add**] button in the Exclusion panel.

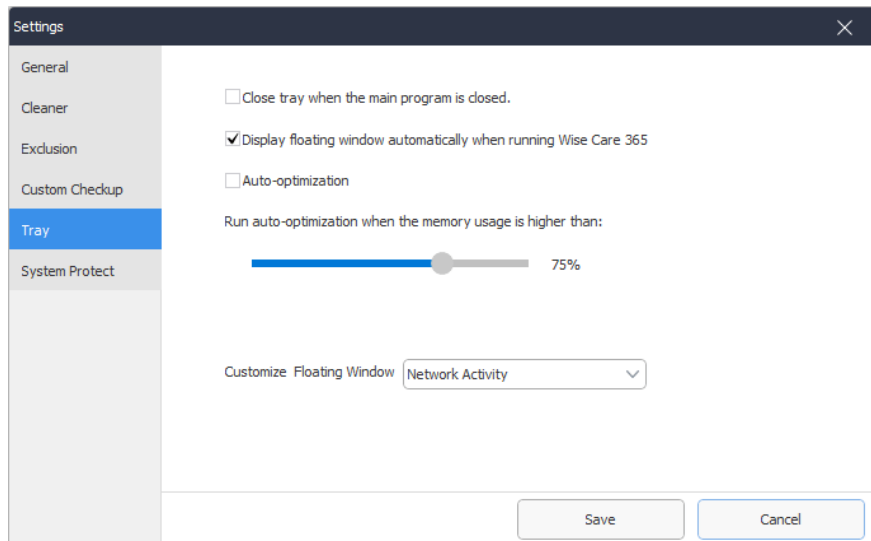
- **Exclusion Folder**
Wise Care 365 will no longer clean up the specified folder. Valid in PC Checkup, Common Cleaner, and Advanced Cleaner.
- **Exclusion File**
Wise Care 365 will no longer clean up the specified file. Valid in PC Checkup, Common Cleaner, and Advanced Cleaner.
- **Exclusion File Type**
Wise Care 365 will no longer clean up files of the specified type. Valid in PC Checkup, Common Cleaner, and Advanced Cleaner.
- **Exclusion Registry Key**
Wise Care 365 will no longer clean up the specified registry entry, which can be a registry path or a keyword. Valid in PC Checkup, Common Cleaner, and Registry Cleaner.
- **Exclusion Domain**
Wise Care 365 will no longer clean up cookies of the specified domain. Valid in PC Checkup and Common Cleaner.

4. Custom Checkup

Customize the content of the PC Checkup. Right-click on any item can restore the list to the default settings.



5. Tray

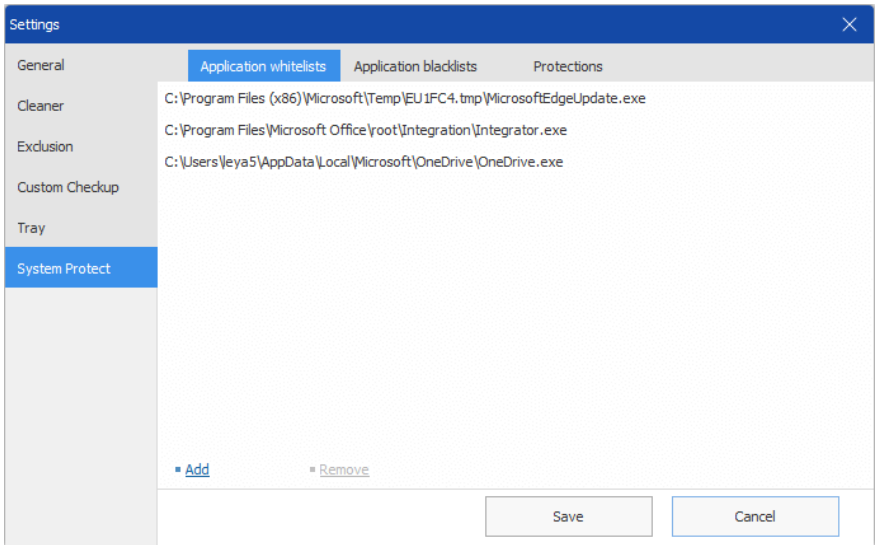


- Close tray when the main program is closed**
 If this option is selected, when you close the Wise Care 365 main window, the Wise Care 365 Tray program in the notification area will also be closed.
- Display floating window automatically when running Wise Care 365**
 The default state is selected. After canceling, the floating window will not be displayed.
- Auto-optimization**
 Set the threshold for automatic memory optimization.
- Customize Floating Window**
 Customize the content displayed on the right side of the floating window, CPU Usage, CPU Temperature, Disk Temperature, Graphic Card Temperature, Mainboard Temperature, and Network Activity.

6. System Protect

Display the programs that are prevented or allowed by Wise Protection. You can add programs that need to be prevented or allowed by clicking the [**Add**] buttons.

Activate the PRO

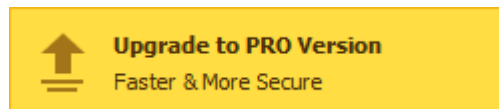

The license key is permanently valid and there is no using-time limitation.

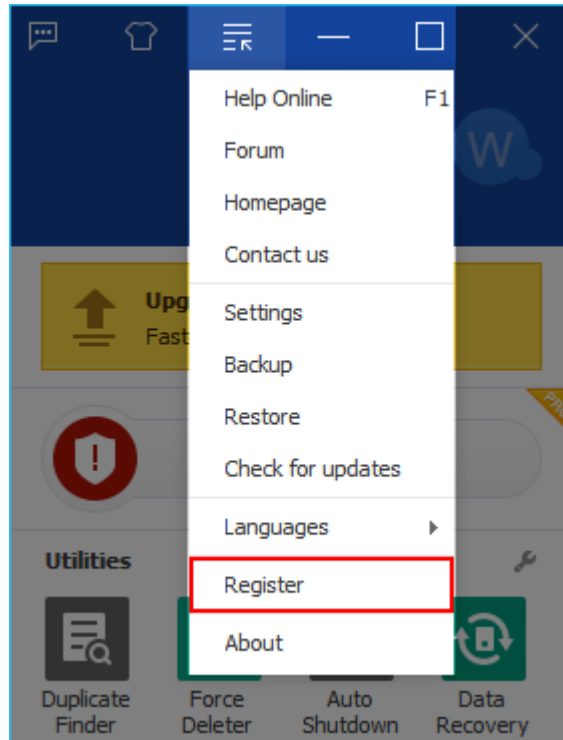
2. Open register window

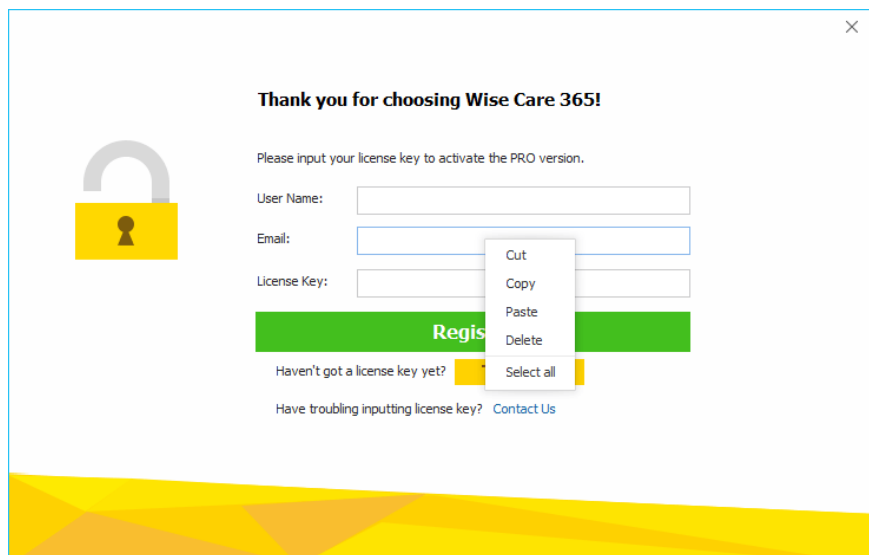

4. FAQs

Invalid license key

The license key entered is incorrect, 0 and o, or there are spaces. After closing the main window of Wise Care 365, re-run the program, reopen the registration window, copy and paste the license key, and check if there is a space before and after the license key.

Can't find your registration information

The email address entered is incorrect or used another product license key.
